The Rotary International monthly theme for January 2026 was Vocational Service Month. Operating under the overarching 2025–2026 yearly theme of "Unite for Good," this month-long focus encouraged Rotarians to maintain high ethical standards in their professions and use their vocational skills to address community needs.

Focus Areas of Vocational Services are:

- **Ethical Leadership:** A strong emphasis on practicing The Four-Way Test and maintaining integrity in all business and professional dealings.
- **Mentorship & Career Development:** Leveraging members' specific professional expertise and networks to mentor young adults, bridge the employment gap, and provide job skills training.
- **Value of All Occupations:** Recognizing the dignity and worth of every profession and demonstrating how vocational talents serve humanity



In Rotary, Vocational Service is one of the foundational pillars of the organization. It represents the responsibility of all members to represent their profession within the club and to embody high ethical standards in their daily business.

- **Key Principles:** Promoting workplace integrity, recognizing the value of all occupations, and contributing professional talents to address societal needs.

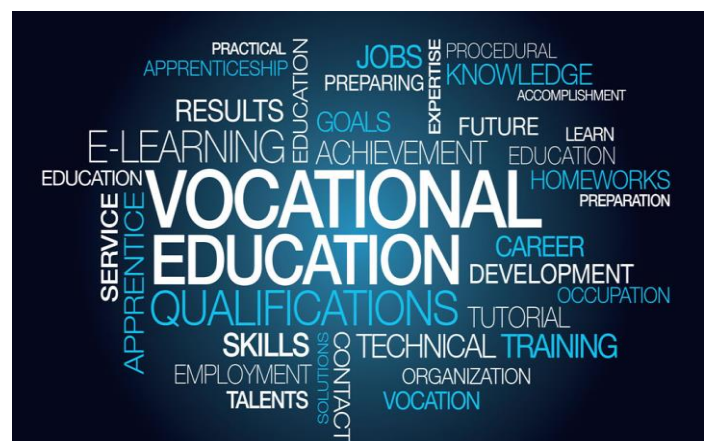
- **Actionable Initiatives:** Members frequently organize mentorship programs, career days for youth, and vocational training teams.

#### Career & Technical Education:

Outside of civic organizations, vocational services refer to technical education and job training. These services prepare individuals for specific trades or professions without the need for a traditional four-year degree.




#### Vocational Rehabilitation:

Vocational services can also refer to state or federally funded programs designed to help individuals—particularly those with disabilities or those re-entering the workforce—overcome barriers to employment. These services include job counseling, resume building, skill training, and job placement.

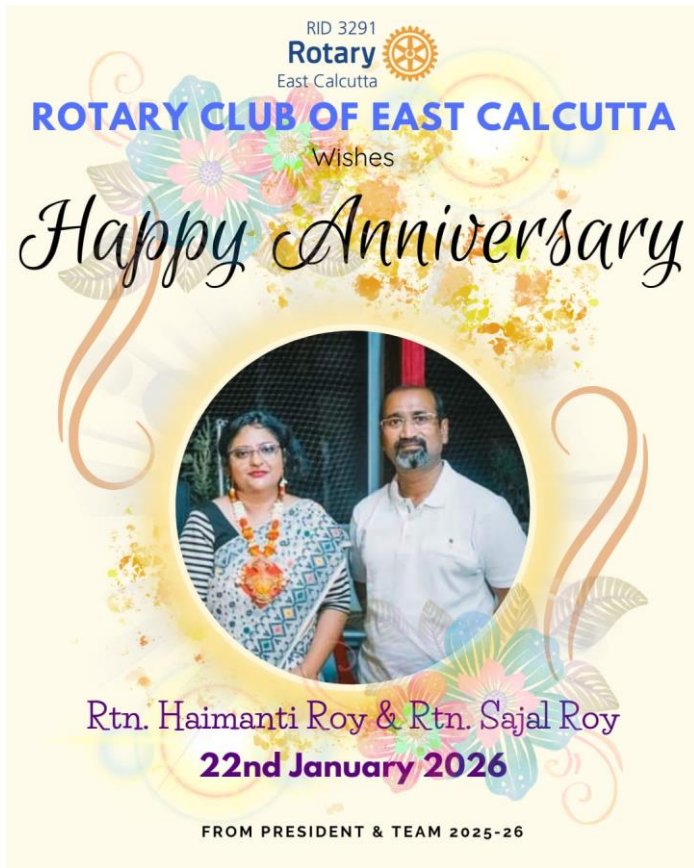
