MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING HELD ON 23/09/2023.

The President welcomed all and proposed, Rtn. Kamal Mukherjee to Chair the BOD Meeting, seconded by the members present in the house.

As desired by the Chair, the President informed the house about the projects to be undertaken in the next 3 months period. He mentioned about a new project "Swarnakana", which has been taken up by RC Madhyamgram. Participants from local schools will be subdivided into 2 groups. The President reminded other members also of the campaign "Each One Bring One" policy proposed last Rotary Year by the district

Finalization of the new modified TRUST deed was discussed. Rtn. Arup Acharya assured of finalizing the same as soon as possible. The president raised the issue of poor attendance in the RWMs and invited suggestions from the members to consider, if the RWM day can be changed from Saturday to either Wednesday or Thursday.

Rtn. Rajib Bannerjee discussed about funding for the Matri Ashram Project. Rtn. Krishanu Chattopadhhay informed that RC Yuvis, Kolkata will not continue to share the 50% of the cost. So, the club has to arrange the balance funds. Rtn. Arup Acharya suggested to have a meeting with the Ashram in-charge to explore if amount of requirement fixed on the basis of present number of inmates.
