MINUTES OF THE RWM No. 3395 OF RC SERAMPORE HELD AT THE CLUB VENUE AT PUJA MEMORIAL COMMUNITY HALL (109/1/A, ARABINDA ROAD), KONNAGAR ON 14 /09/2024, AT 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order, assisted by Rtn. Rajib in absence of the Secretary. Rtn. Krishanu reported that he along with the President and other members visited 3 schools for getting registration of students with regard to participation in the ensuing Swarnakona project. They explained the school authorities regarding eligibility criteria and the procedure for registration and other formalities. The project will be held on 6th October.

Rtn. Krishanu also informed that our club has got two numbers of water filters. The club decided to give these two water filters to the Little Millennium School at Hindmotor and Anjuman Girls High School of Rishra. 4 sewing machines will be collected from R C Calcutta Welfare Trust on 12th October. He mentioned that he is trying to get 100 school bags for our club.

The President informed that the Knapsack distribution at Polba has ultimately been held on 13th September. 60 mosquito nets, arranged by R C Galaxy, Kolkata, were also distributed.

Rtn Krishanu informed that a global project is under implementation in which a mobile van is being arranged for cancer detection program. Clubs may join in the project by contributing 500 USD.

Rtn Ganguly informed that he has attended the Award Ceremony for the year 2023-24, held on 8th September and could gather from the deliberation that if club want to get awards, citation at District level or at the RI level then they have to participate in Global Grant project, bring new members and contribute to the RI's various funds.

He also requested the President to endsure proper and timely online uploading of projects and club activities.

He mentioned that timely uploading may also help proper reporting in the GML.

The President informed that he has discussed the issue of monthly contribution to the Matri Ashram and it has been agreed that henceforth we will contribute @ Rs 3,000/- per month.

Rtn Rajib informed that he has handed over clothes at the Destitute Home and he has donated Rs 5,000/- to the SnehaNeer as financial support for the specially abled children. Members thanked Rtn Rajib.

Rtn Kalyan Mukherjee informed that he has spoken to Dr. Kalyan Mukherjee with regard to setting up of one Rotary Clinic jointly with Dr. Kalyan's establishment at Masterpara where poor people may avail complete and long term treatment (three months) by registering with a minimum charges of Rs. 270/-. The house agreed to that proposal.

There was no announcement for the last week period.

Sgt- at Arms declared that the number of members present was 9.

There being no agenda left for discussion, the President terminated the meeting.
