MINUTES OF THE RWM No. 3399 OF RC SERAMPORE HELD AT THE CLUB VENUE AT PUJA MEMORIAL COMMUNITY HALL (109/1/A, ARABINDA ROAD), KONNAGAR ON 19/10/2024, AT 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order, assisted by the Secretary.

Discussion was held with regards to the arrangements for holding of 'World Polio Day' on 24th October. It was decided to arrange miking with banners in the local area to raise awareness. Rtn. Sandip Banerjee gave a brief report on the Polio Seminar he attended at Gyan Manch.

Rtn. Sandip also requested the house to hold a detailed discussion on deciding that who will be the President elect for the year 2025-2026 urgently as the matter is long overdue. After long discussion and request by the house, Rtn. Uttam Bhattacharjee agreed to be the club President for the Rotary Year 2025-2026. Rtn. krishanu made a formal proposal and the members agreed. Rtn. Krishanu requested the president to fix a date from the available dates, proposed by the Chittaranjan Cancer hospital for arranging Cervical Cancer awareness and screening project during the year. He also requested the club to start the proposed Training Centre with 4 sewing machines we got recently. This training will be provided by the Singer Company.

Rtn. subhabrata proposed to form a committee to oversee the training project. The President requested Rtn. Krishanu, Rtn. Uttam, Rtn. Sisir and Rtn. Subhabrata to be the committee members for this project. The Inner Wheel Club will also be requested to join the project.

Rtn. Krishanu informed that 148 students have registered from the schools on behalf of RC Serampore to participate in the 'swarnakana Project'.

He also informed that he is trying to arrange vaccination for 300 school girls, aged between 9-14 years during our proposed Cervical Cancer awareness and Screening project.

On 6th October Rtn. Subhamay Guha Roy's and on 12th October Rtn. Kaushik Sinha's Birthday were announced.

Sgt-at arms declared that there were 15 members present in the meeting.

There being no agenda left to discuss, the President terminated the meeting.
