Kolkata : Several puja organisers in the city are going the extra mile to promote inclusivity, making the festivities accessible for all. These pandals have wheelchair ramps, dedicated volunteers and separate walkways for senior citizens, Braille stands to explain themes, and feeding rooms for new mothers.

At SB Park in Behala Thakurpukur, the organisers are constructing make-shift AC baby-care rooms, as well as rooms for tired senior citizens and disabled

visitors. "We will also have Braille display stands and have decked up our pandal in a manner so that none feels left out. We will have separate facilities for the blind and other differently abled persons apart from dedicated volunteers to take them around the pandal premises," said club president Sanjay Majumder.

Organisers of Dum Dum Park Tarun Sangha and Salt Lake's BJ Block puja have made wide and low-gradient ramps for wheelchair-bound visitors and senior citizens. "
