

CHANDANPIRI VISIT

On September 28, 2024, PP Rtn Anirudha Gupta, PP Rtn Amaresh Bhattacharya, PP Rtn Kaushik Bhattacharya and his spouse Sunetra, PP Rtn Bikash Dutta, and President Rtn Angshuman Bhattacharya visited Chandanpiri to review the progress of our ongoing toilet project, a collaborative effort with EIRWT of District 3291. After a productive discussion with the President and Secretary of the RCC regarding the project's current status, the team visited several beneficiary households where water tanks and connecting pipelines had been installed. One beneficiary demonstrated the entire system, showing how water is pumped from a nearby pond to overhead storage and flows through a tap connected to the toilet.

The club members were pleased with the project's progress. Of the 43 toilets scheduled for completion, 41 have been finished, and the remaining two are expected to be completed within a week. Once these are finalized, we will have reached our target of connecting 100 toilets. Preparations are already in place to begin the installation of an additional 57 toilets. The RCC has been requested to gather the necessary documentation from identified beneficiaries to facilitate the next phase.

In addition, our club donated 30 sarees to the RCC for distribution to local women ahead of the upcoming Puja festivities, thanks to the generous contributions of PP Rtn Anirudha Gupta and PP Rtn Bikash Dutta. Chocolates and ice creams were also distributed among the children at the Ashram, courtesy of our members.

During the visit, we met with a new vendor identified for our Roshni project. The vendor demonstrated a solar-powered lighting system designed to be installed on fishing boats, providing illumination for night fishing trips. The RCC President will consult with beneficiaries to gather feedback on the system's functionality. As a pilot, the vendor will install one unit on a fishing boat to evaluate its effectiveness during night fishing operations. Additionally, the RCC President has been asked to report back on issues that have emerged with the 10 solar-powered systems previously installed, and to coordinate with the original vendor for necessary repairs.

The RCC has also expressed interest in joining us for our upcoming mega project on Cervical Cancer Vaccination. We will reach out to them once the project is officially launched. Lastly, the President of the RCC extended an invitation for club members to join the Durga Puja celebrations at their Ashram.


