Minutes of the 2677th Regular Club Meeting of Rotary Club of Behala held at Malik Guest House, Harish Mukherjee Road at 6.30 PM on 1st Aug., 2024

- At the 2676th RCM meeting, Club President Rtn Angshuman Bhattacharya took charge and started off with the National Anthem, led by Rtn Sanghamitra Duttagupta. The President thanked all members for their unwavering support in making the Installation program a resounding success.
- During the meeting, the President highlighted the successful organization of an Adolescent Health Awareness Camp at Barisha High School in Kolkata, in collaboration with the Indian Academy of Paediatrics, WB Branch. The event saw the participation of around 100 boys and girls, with senior Paediatricians from IAP addressing various medical and mental health issues encountered during adolescence. Additionally, a Q&A session was highly interactive. Our Club members, including President, PP Dr. Siddhartha Chakraborty, Rtn Sunit Roy, and Rtn Dhruba Mazumder, represented the Rotary Club of Behala and gifted three ceiling fans to the school.
- Furthermore, President Rtn Angshuman informed members about receiving a grant of Rs.3 lakh from EIRWT, along with the Club's contribution of Rs.1.50 lakh, for building 63 additional toilets at Chandanpiri. PP Rtn Anirudha Gupta elaborated on their recent visit to Chandanpiri, where they met the beneficiaries of the toilet project and discussed potential future initiatives. On a generous note, PP Anirudha, on behalf of his Family Trust, donated Rs.1 lakh to the club for the purpose of providing scholarships to economically weak girl students of Chandanpiri, which all members warmly acknowledged.
- Additionally, members expressed gratitude to Rtn Shakuntala Ghosh Hazra for donating a Compact Touch B scan USG machine to an eye hospital in Kolkata through our club. The President then announced the upcoming activities for August, including the Independence Day flag hoisting program, a joint meeting with RC Calcutta Charnock City, and invitations to the Installation Ceremony of the Interact club at Bridge International School and the Charter Day celebration of our Club at Tollygunge Club. The President requested full participation from all members for these events, with each member and their spouse being invited to the Charter Day celebration program on 24th August, 2024.
