Despite tremendous hurdles, she refused to let her limitations define her and instead focused on her talents and abilities. She helped to tear down barriers for persons with disabilities and inspire future generations through her relentless advocacy work.

Her tale is a strong example of the strength, fortitude, and resilience that each of us possesses, and it inspires us to embrace our own potential and follow our dreams with tenacity and perseverance.
