Combined data from multiple studies suggests that the rate of all orofacial clefts, which means either a cleft lip or a cleft palate, is one in 770 births in India." There is evidence that cleft lip and/or palates are more common in the west of India, and rarer in the east of India.

Cleft lip surgery India is a costly affair and Mission-smile has taken a step forward to help those who are suffering form this major deformity.

A dedicated and energetic team of doctors, nursing staffs, volunteers and program coordinators works together in Mission Smile to correct the deformity caused by Cleft Palate. Mission Smile is a Medical Charitable Trust which is providing comprehensive cleft care since 2002 in India.

Mission Smile team cheers up the kids prior to surgery and the doctors working to achieve perfect surgery. The kids and their families reflect nervousness and hopes for a better future. Due to lack of awareness regarding the corrective surgery, a person born with cleft lip or palate lives a life full of perils of social stigma and medical challenges.
