REPORT ON FLOOD RELIEF AT UDAYNARAYANPUR - HOWRAH ON 24-09-2024.

Heavy rainfall and discharge of water from Damodar Corporation Valley led to severe flooding in Southern West Bengal. Six districts were significantly impacted by the floods. Out of these, the worst affected areas were Ghatal in West Medinipur and Udaynarayanpur in Howrah. The release of water from the dams and reservoirs had worsened the situation.

Rotary Club of Calcutta North East extended their helping hand to 70 families of the Bagdi Caste in the flood affected villages of Kanuput and Monsukha in the Udaynarayanpur Block in Howrah. Dry food items like Muri, Murki, Maggi, Sattu, Biscuits and Batasa, Medicines and ORS were donated. The packing of the items and the distribution was carried out in a very efficient manner led by Project Chairman IPP Rtn Vivekananda Bhowmick.

The project was executed on 24th September. The members who joined the project were President Rtn Subasish Halder, President Elect Rtn Angana Paul, IPP Rtn Vivekananda Bhowmick, Editor Rtn Chandra Kumar Paul, Project Chair PP Rtn Shubadip Roy, PP Rtn Ramprasad Chattopadhyay and Rtn Sabyasachi Roy. Mrs Mahua Das, well wisher of our club also joined us in the project. PP Rtn Biswajit Chaudhuri assisted in transporting the logistics. ROTARY COMMITS FUNDS TO POLIO OUTBREAK RESPONSE IN GAZA

The recent detection of variant poliovirus type-2 isolates in environmental samples and the confirmation of a 10-month-old child who has contracted polio in Gaza is a stark reminder that as long as polio exists anywhere, it is a threat everywhere.

The ongoing crisis in Gaza has contributed to reduced routine immunization rates and an increased risk of vaccine-preventable diseases, including polio. The crisis also poses a significant challenge to fully implementing disease surveillance and vaccination campaigns.



The World Health Organization (WHO) considers there to be a high risk for the spread of this polio strain within Gaza and internationally, particularly given the current situation's impact on public health services.

A humanitarian pause has allowed a two-round polio vaccination campaign that began in Gaza on 1 September. Initial reports indicate the campaign started successfully, with teams showing strong commitment and high levels of community participation.

Rotary is committing US\$500,000 to bolster the initiative, channeling these funds through a dedicated Polio Outbreak Response Fund. This contribution represents Rotary's sustained support to the WHO in combating polio globally.

Rotary will continue to work with its partners in the Global Polio Eradication Initiative and other agencies as vaccination efforts unfold.

Financial contributions to the PolioPlus fund will help Rotary and its Global

Polio Eradication Initiative partners achieve a world in

which no child is paralyzed by polio again.
