

**PROJECT STOP CHILD MARRIAGE:** Child marriage continues to be a deeply ingrained social issue, affecting numerous countries including India. Our club is dedicated to safeguarding the rights of Indian children through integrated initiatives of overall development.

The event was organized in collaboration with Walls Hospital. The hospital provided free physical examinations, blood sugar tests, blood pressure checks, and egg tests alongwith discounted rates for further diagnostic tests at the hospital. Approximately 200 local residents attended the camp. The successful organization of the camp was attributed to the guidance of Rtn. Asghar Ali and other members of R.C. Cal. Park Point.

# The 4-Way Test A Test for all times and all people

Herbert J. Taylor, a Chicago Rotarian propounded 24 words magic test in 1932.

The young businessman, Herbert J. Taylor left his executive position in a food company to take over a sinking cooking utensil firm at the instance of its creditors.

A personal bank loan to Herbert Taylor prevented a total collapse of the company. The impending disaster disturbed his mind continuously.

#### In the words Herbert J. Taylor:-

"One day in July 1932, I decided to pray about the matter. That morning I leaned over my desk and asked God to give us a simple guide to help us think, speak and do that which was right. I immediately picked up a white card and wrote out The 4 - Way Test of the things we think, say or do as follows:

- 1. Is it the Truth?
- 2. Is it Fair to all concerned?
- 3. Will it build Goodwill and Better Friendships?
- 4. Will it be Beneficial to all concerned?

The 4-Way Test was born. Herbert Taylor further said that "before letting it known to others the test had its own testing time".

He said that "I placed the little test under the glass of my desk and determined to try it out for a few days before talking to anyone else in the company about it. I had a very discouraging experience. I almost threw it into the waste paper basket the first day." He further said "After about 60 days of faithful, constant effort on my part to live upto the The 4-Way Test, I was thoroughly sold on its great worth and at the same time greatly humiliated and at times, discouraged with my own performance as President of the Company."

He continued to say that "I discussed it with my four department Heads. One was a Roman Catholic, the second a Christian Scientist, the third an Orthodox Jew and the fourth a Presbyterian."

"I asked each man either or not there was anything in the The 4-Way Test which was contrary to the doctrines and ideals of his particular faith. The all four agreed that truth, justice, friendliness and helpfulness not only consided with their religious ideals, but that if constantly applied in business they should result in greater success and progress."

These four men agreed to use The 4-Way Test in checking proposed plans, policies, statements and advertising of the company. Later all employees were asked to memorise and use The 4-Way Test in their relations with others.

He further said "The application of The 4-Way Test to our relations with our own personnel and that of our suppliers and customers helped us to win their friendship and goodwill. We have learned that the friendship and confidence of those with whom we associate is essential to permanent success in business."

"From a bankrupt condition in 1932 our company within a period of some twenty years had paid its debts in full, had paid its stockholders over one million dollars in dividends and had a value of our two million dollars."

He continued to say that "The 4-Way Test have been even greater than the financial ones. We have enjoyed a constant increase in the goodwill, friendship and confidence of our customers, our competitors and the public and what is even more valuable, a great improvement in the moral character of our own Personnel".

Rotarian Dr. Edwin Bracknev of Rotary Club of Windermere, Florida organised The 4-Way Test eassy contest each year for 17 years. Some Clubs have been established as annual 4 way test week.

In 1954-55, when Herbert J. Taylor became Rotary International President, he presented the copyright of the 4 - way test to Rotary International.



## In the light of the above The 4- Way Test is reproduced as under:-

The 4-WayTest of the things we think, say or do.

- 1. Is it the TRUTH?
- 2. Is it FAIR to all concerned?
- 3. Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
- 4. Will it be BENERCIAL to all concerned?

The 4-Way Test is not referred to as a code in any sense.
