10th September : Cervical Cancer Awareness Camp cum 320th RWM

Cervical Cancer Vaccination Awareness Programme was organised by Rotary Club of Calcutta Visionaries with support of the program team at Masat Girls High School, Ramchandrapur, 24 Parganas South, W.B, near Dostipur More, as part of the Rotary Global Grant Project for Cervical Cancer Prevention.

The project, managed by the Rotary Club of Belur (District 3291) in partnership with Singapore Heartlands, District 3310, also received support from Rotary Clubs of Hooghly, Calcutta Chowrenghee, Chandannagar, Visionaries, and Young Indians, a philanthropic organization of young corporate leaders. Narayana Hospital partnered to provide medical support.

The project's aims to vaccinate over 1200 girls aged 9 to 14 across several schools in and around Kolkata including Howrah, Hooghly, and South 24 Parganas. Masat Girls High School, with over 1500 students from classes 5 to 12, was chosen for this awareness camp by the Rotary Club of Calcutta Visionaries.

Rtn Nikhil of RC Cal Visionaries explained the purpose of the camp to the house which was followed by a detailed information by Rtn Tarun Kanti Pal of RC Belur who explained about the project. This was followed by a detailed insight on Cervical Cancer in local vernacular Bengali by the Dy. CMOH DH1 Dr Himadri Haldar, who explained to the parents the reasons of susceptibility to the disease as well as the options available to a patient for treatment. He also informed the availability of the vaccination for prevention of the disease. Project Manager Alokeparna Ghosh presented a detailed PowerPoint on cervical cancer and its prevention methods, PDG Mukul Sinha delivered a motivational talk on cervical cancer prevention and the importance of the vaccination camps organized by the project. while Dr Reema Roy Gynaecologist answered to the questions of the parents.

The campaign was highly successful, with a responsive audience. The school administration has been requested to obtaining consent letters for vaccination of their child from parents, to be followed by organizing the vaccination camp for the first dosage.







11th September: In an effort to improve the comfort and well-being of the elderly residents, of a special initiative was taken to distribute pillows to the residents of our Old Age Home; Rotary Ramthakur Briddhabas, at Anandpur.

The primary objective was to provide them with a better quality of sleep and alleviate the discomfort that may arise from inadequate bedding. The pillows were carefully selected, ensuring they offered proper support and comfort for the elderly individuals who may have specific health concerns like neck or back pain. Rotarians and staff members took part in the distribution process, making sure that each resident received a pillow suited to their needs. Rtn Manish Chauchcharia made all the necessary arrangements.

This gesture, while small, was met with great appreciation by the residents, who expressed their gratitude for the thoughtful act.
