

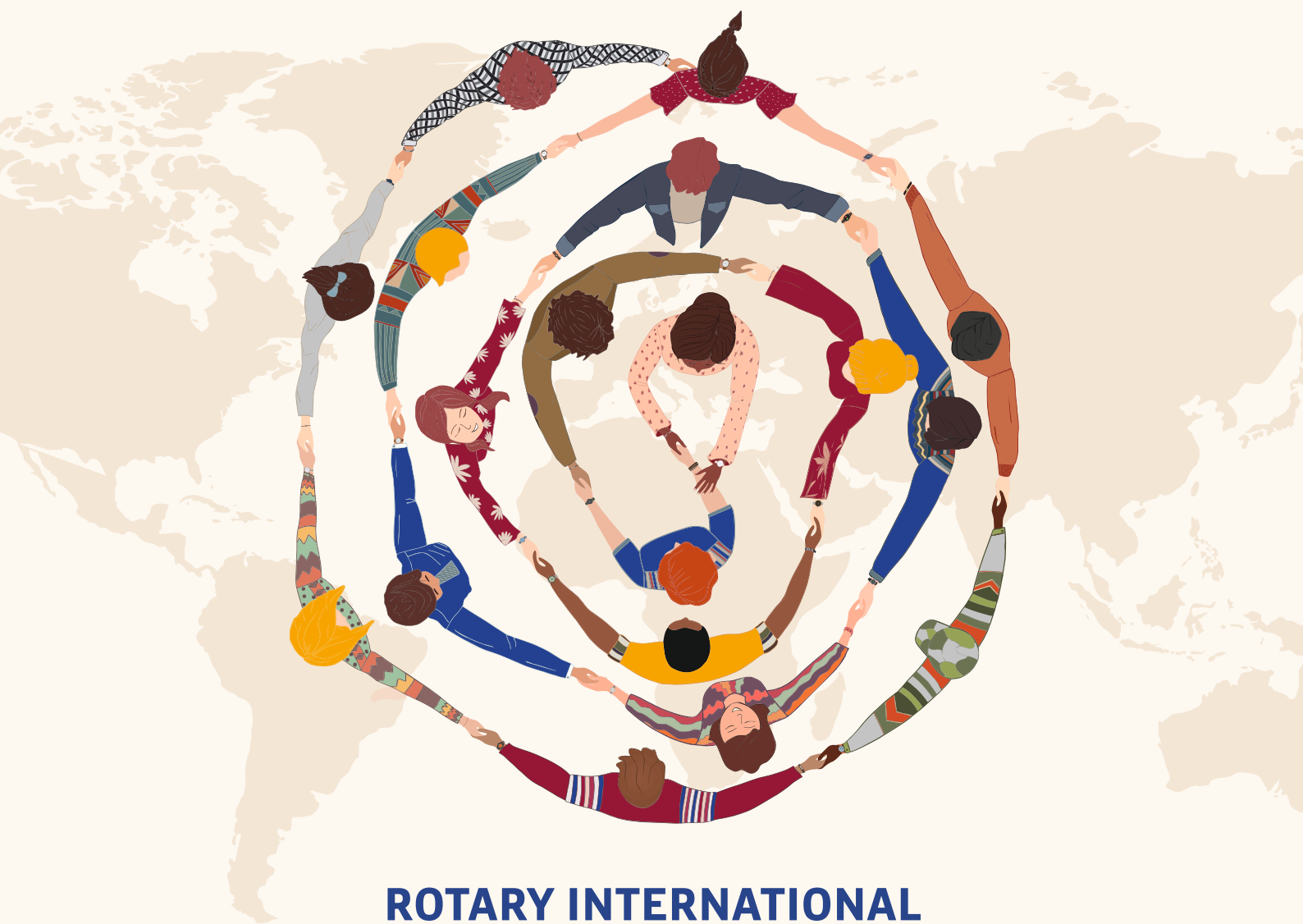

SERVICE PROJECTS SEPTEMBER

1. Joynagar Health Camp (Healthy Families, Happy Communities)

Camp was organized on 6th in association with Neotia Hospital. Parents and children from the community were given free health checkups, awareness & guidance. Required medicines were distributed free. 150 children were treated with general medicines and their malnutrition diagnosis checkups were done too.



2. Cervical Cancer Awareness

The camp was also held on 6th. PP Manisha Srivastava was present. 250 mothers and young adults, teenagers attended the awareness camp. This camp is part of our global grant for cervical cancer and will be followed up with two doses of the cervical cancer vaccine.

3. USK Amragori

A handicap camp part of USK GG, at Amoragori Juba Sangha was organised on 9th for 50 beneficiaries conducted by MSS. The artificial limbs were prepared there & fitted with 2 days. It was attended by PP Manisha Srivastava, President Vidhi Beri and Secretary Vineet Bagaria.



4. Arika Heart Surgery

Arika Kumari had a heart device closure on 10th as part of our initiative to support the Neotia Newtown hospital in mother and child health. Our club is focusing on infant and child care from rural and remote areas where we are specifically trying to give access to marginalised communities and their children for enhanced medical care.

5. Nutrition Awareness

President Vidhi Beri conducted on 11th a talk on nutrition & health for children (2-5) & parents at Daffodil High School under Teach for India initiative. The school encourages the children to come back with food charts as part of their continuous learning about health and self care.



6. Cycle Donation

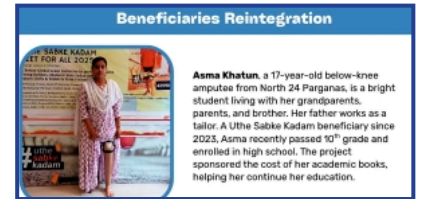


24. Dental Camp
