

Disease Prevention & Control





Uthe Sabke Kadam - Feet for All - 10th September, 2023 witnessed a significant event as RC Chowrenghee organized a mega camp for prosthesis at Amragori, our new RCC in collaboration with Mahavir Seva Sadan. Assessment of 60 beneficiaries was done by doctors and technicians of MSS. The fitment of prosthesis took place from the 14th sept. to 16th September and on 17th September distribution of these prosthesis was done to 81 beneficiaries.



On **8th October**, leg prosthesis was provided to 23 beneficiaries at Mahavir Seva Sadan. On the 15th October, again this was provided to 33 beneficiaries at

MSS. Special appreciation goes to Rtn. Varda Goenka for her unwavering commitment to attending these Sunday camps.





"Udaan Zindagi Mein"- Give Wings to Life" - Under project "Udaan Zindagi Mein"-Give Wings to Life", seven students, beneficiaries of prosthesis at MSS have already received educational sponsorships from our club members.



Dental Camp - On 20th of September, a Dental Camp was organised at Kishorepur Girls High School in Egaragram, Aamtallah RCC. in collaboration with Colgate, by Rtn. Dr. Surana. 129 students were checked up and adviced about oral hygiene. Toothbrushes and toothpaste were distributed to all.



Eye Camp - On 29th of October, an Eye camp was conducted by our club at Amragori Juba Sangha in collaboration with Rotary Gangadharpur Eye Hospital, Howrah. 236 patients were examined by three doctors of Rotary Gangadharpur Eye hospital and the hospital will conduct free IOL surgeries for 124 patients and RC Chowrenghee will give free spectacles for 89 patients.



World Polio Day - On 24th October 2023, since World Polio Day and Dussehra had fallen on the same day, our club put Banners in Puja Pandals at Park Circus and distributed fliers and put banners at Puja pandals in our RCC at Amragori promoting Rotary's work in Polio eradication and awareness.

Weekly Medical Dispensaries

Our weekly medical dispensaries at Kumirmari , Shivtallah and Uluberia continue to serve their communities effectively.

Basic Education & Literacy





Veerangana - On 12th September 2023,"Veerangana", a power packed project on Self defense, along with yoga and meditation was successfully conducted at RCV. It was attended by 45 students. Donation of Sports Equipment at RCV - Donation of Sports Equipment at Rotary Chowrenghee Vidyalaya under Happy School was made on 10 th October, 2023 where President Meena Khemka donated a trampoline, a basketball net with a stand, a punching bag with boxing gloves and a tent for recreational activities

Adult Literacy - Our Club has taken responsibility for nine centres in Howrah dedicated to Adult Literacy, adhering to the guidelines established by RILM with 265 adults on their way to literacy in 60 sessions.



Water & Sanitation

On 13 th October RC Belur had a closure ceremony of the WINS Global Grant Project. Out of the 20 Schools that were part of this project, 6 schools received proper toilets and hand wash stations through our club. Urmi Basu spearheaded this project on our behalf.





On 29th of October, under Project Unnati, we inaugurated two tubewells in collaboration with Bees Trees and Water and local partner New Light at Amragori, Howrah.50 private toilets to 50 families at Amragori were also assigned.







Community & Economic Development

Nabadisha - On 9th September, Our club participated in the Nabadisha programme in collaboration with District 3291 and Karaya Police station provided much needed support to 60 under privileged children dwelling on the streets of kolkata.

Fundraiser "Unnatti" – Hope with Art - On 21st & 22nd of September, "Unnatti-Hope with Art", a momentous fundraising event orchestrated by the Rotary Club of Calcutta Chowrenghee, in partnership with Gallery Sanskriti to transform lives and illuminate hope of 1500 villagers of Amragori was a remarkable success. On 17th October, 2023 our club distributed 400 packets of reusable, washable 'Stree' sanitary pads at Dum Dum Women Correctional Home in collaboration with Rotary Club of Central Calcutta.

On 30th and 31st October, Diwali edition of our fundraiser 'Parampara', was a remarkable success.









B.D.M.International - A Donation Drive from the Interact Club of B.D.M.I. was organized during the last week of September. Keeping with the theme of 'Daan Utsav'- Celebrating the Joy of Giving, on 5th October, the Interactors and the scouts & guides visited two NGOs 'Uttor Kolkata Ananda Mandir' and 'Sarala Punyasram' to donate various wearables and stationery items.

As part of the 'Agomoni' Programme On 13 October, 25 guests from Navanir -an old age home were presented with sarees and hand-made gift items crafted by the students themselves.

Again, as part of this programme the students from Samaritan Help Mission mesmerized all with their dance performance on 16 October, 2023 and were given goodie bags and a token of appreciation.

13 class IX students took up the role of a Scribe or Amanuensis for the Ramakrishna Mission Blind Boys' Academy, Narendrapur where they helped the blind boys to write their Madhyamik Pariksha Selection Test. They were felicitated on 17 October, 2023 for their selfless service. On 18 October, the Interactors visited an NGO: 'Save the Orphans, Save the Old Age' where edible items were distributed to all.







The Interact Club of IVWS organized a number of activities during this time. The Interactors distributed 200 sets of new clothes to underprivileged girls and boys in the remote areas of the Sundarbans in collaboration with SHER. They also arranged for the collection of new clothes for underprivileged children and arranged for their distribution along with YES Bank. The residents of the old age home Shibasram were invited to enjoy a cultural programme to celebrate "agomoni" and were presented with blankets. The children from Jyotirmai Seva Mandir -a NGO were invited to participate in the "agomoni" celebration at IVWS alongside children from other schools and presented them with stationery kits. The Interactors visited the NGO Jan Seva and presented the children with food treats. The Interactors observed the International Day of Older Persons with the residents of Shibasram through a short cultural program and presented them with gift hampers. In order to encourage fun while learning, educational toys were distributed to the Pre-Primary children of the Future Hope school. Three NGOs namely, Disha Foundation, Ishwar Sankalpa and the Indian Institute of





Cerebral Palsy (IICP) were invited to put up counters on the days of the school PTMs to hel the NGOs to raise funds and awareness.
