

Vocational Training Centres: Centre 1: Swabalambi Tailoring Training Center was established by RCC Narishakti Foundation, Garia, with the support of Rotary Club of Calcutta Endeavour, RID. The initiative aims to promote women empowerment, encourage income generation in rural areas, and contribute to the holistic development of underprivileged communities. The







Centre 2: The Swabalambi Tailoring Training Center is managed by RCC Narishakti Foundation and supported by the Rotary Club of Calcutta Endeavour, RID 3291. Located in Mollahati, Nilkunthi, the center is dedicated to providing free tailoring training to rural residents, with a special focus on empowering women.

The primary goal of this initiative is to equip women with skills that enable them to earn a livelihood, support their families, and contribute to the socio-economic development of their communities.



Currently, the centre has 20 trainees, and training sessions are held three days a week for three hours per session, completely free of cost.



Centre 3: The Swabalambi Tailoring Training Center, located at Dakshin Haradhanpur, Gangasagar, is a vocational training initiative aimed at the socioeconomic upliftment of rural communities. This center is supported by RC Calcutta Endeavour as part of its commitment to women empowerment and sustainable livelihood development. The first batch commenced with 14 women trainees, who received free tailoring training for 3 hours a day, 3 days a week. Building on the success of the first batch, the second batch is now underway,



with 17 women enrolled. They are continuing to receive the same free training, focused on income generation and personal development. Through this initiative, women are gaining valuable skills that empower them to become financially independent and contribute to the progress of their families and communities.
