The Mayfair Eye Care Unit was started for primary eye care.

The main objectives of the clinic is to:

- Provide daily eye check-up facilities for patients from economically weaker sections.
- Screen and identify cataract and refractive error cases for further treatment or surgery.
- Promote community awareness on eye care and hygiene.
- Ensure timely referral of serious cases to Rotary Joynagar Eye Hospital for specialized intervention.

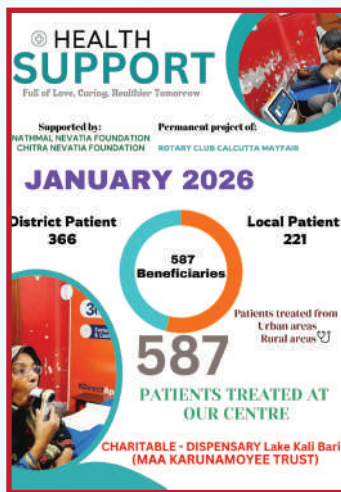
January 2026 COMMUNITY MARRIAGE
