Extending Financial Support to Sk. Nazib to Pay His University Dues

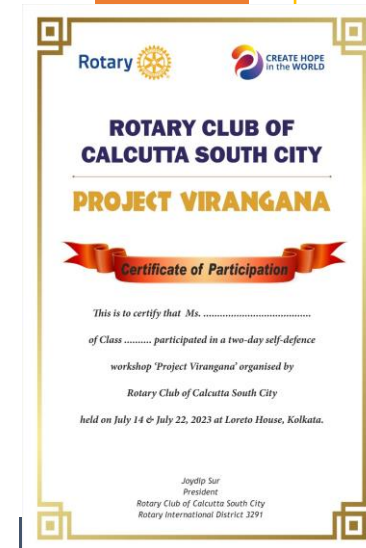
RCCSC was fortunate to extend financial help to Sk. Nazib, a student of St. Xavier's University, Rajarhat, to complete his Masters in Social Work.
