Our club donated 40 medicinal plants to THK Jain college for their garden. Almost 80 students and 20 faculty members attended the program.



Club organised workshop on **thalassemia awareness for marriage registrars** of WB, aiming to spread message to would be couples through the registrars. Out of about 1,000 marriage registrars we could address about 500 at programs held at Midnapur and Kolkata. Another 180 registrars were explained about the importance of awareness on thalassemia at Siliguri, North Bengal on 28 July.



Our PP Dr R Hom Chaudhuri along with other members reached Siliguri at 9.30 in the morning. They addressed the gathering from 10.30 am to 1 pm, which was attended by the Registrar General also. Next seminar will be organised at Asansol shortly. The team returned to Calcutta by Vande Bharat Exp on the same evening.



100 tissue cultured banana plantlets were bought from tissue culture lab Ramkrishna Mission University for plantation at Govt TB Hospital, Boral. Moreover 100 plants were donated to the hospital on 28 July including saplings of medicinal trees and others, which were collected from Forest Department.
