RCCY welcomes DG on his Official Visit ▼

A Philanthropist by Passion with Better Health, Better Education and Wellness for All, as his Mission, Dr. Ramendu Homchaudhuri started his Rotary Journey in the year 2006.

As an Iconic Member of Rotary Club of Calcutta Sun City, he started as the Chairperson of the Organizing Committee of District Assembly 2007. He served as President of Rotary Club of Calcutta Sun City for two successive terms in 2009-10 and 2010-11. His in-depth involvement as a Rotarian had already started.

His First Mega Project was Transit Trauma Care in collaboration with Kolkata Police & Government of West Bengal, where 15 Ambulances were flagged off that were strategically placed in various Accident Prone Locations of Kolkata. The core aim was to reach any Accident location at the earliest, provide on the spot care through the Trained Staff in the Ambulance and Transport the victim to the nearest Appropriate Medical Facility. This was to take care of the Appropriate Actions in the Golden Hour following an Accident, which are of Paramount Importance in Saving an Accident Victim's Life.

Dr. Homchaudhuri's name has now become synonymous with Thalassemia Eradication Mission. His untiring efforts in this area, in his Personal Capacity, as a Sun City Member, as a District Official & Initiator of Zero Thalassemia Foundation, need no further explanation. He has functioned as the District Chair for Thalassemia Awareness and Prevention, conducting various Seminars across West Bengal, Assam, Bangladesh & Sri Lanka. Preventable Killer Disease.

For the last over Three Years, he has taken up the Mantle as a Key Representative of Rotary Club of Calcutta Sun City along with Hridham, another NGO, to provide easy access to potable water to the Water Scarce village of Dhaska in Purulia District. Continuous efforts are ongoing under his Relentless Actions and Guidance in Digging Ponds, Educating the Children & Adults, Developing Innovative Income Generating Sources for the Villagers of Dhaska as a whole.

Dr. Homchaudhuri added another feather to his cap with a rare distinction of getting Elected Unanimously as District Governor Nominee and would be taking over as District Governor in the Rotary Year 2025-26.

He is extremely fortunate to have his spouse, Dr. Mrs. Bandana Hom Chaudhuri, a reputed Pediatrician in her own right, giving him support in each of his endeavours. She is also a Past President of Rotary Club of Calcutta Sun City and has been working in various capacities in District 3291 Administration. They are blessed with a daughter and a son. The daughter is a Doctor and son is a Post-Doctoral Research Scholar in Robotics, based in USA.

Dr. Ramendu Homchaudhuri completed his MBBS in 1970 from Gauhati University, DGO from Calcutta University and followed it up with MS(Orthopedics) from Banaras Hindu University.

Amidst all his abovementioned activities, whenever he can manage his time, Dr. Homchaudhuri practices his Profession as an Orthopedic Surgeon of undisputed repute with an ever smiling & energetic persona, which is an integral part of his profile.

PROJECT & ACTIVITIES FOR ROTARY YEAR 2025-26

Suchita - Low Cost Toilet Construction: It's the Signature Project of RCCY for last few years. This year we completed the construction and handed over of 48 Low Cost Toilets to the Beneficiaries in Birlapur Area. With this the cumulative figure of handover of the Low cost Toilet construction stands at 1570.

Hariyali – Distribution of Fruit Bearing Plant Saplings: Our Club has been doing Distribution and plantation of Fruit Bearing Plant sapling for many years. The initiative not only supports Environment but also promotes community well being since it helps those families in their Earnings in future when these plants start giving Fruits. During the Year RCCY distributed 7955 Fruit bearing Plant Saplings benefitting 1700 Families in various locations like Sonarpur, Baruipur, Joynagar, Bhangar during July to September.

IOL Camps for Free Cataract Surgery: This has been our Flagship Project since inception. IOL camps are being organised by Yuvis every year. This year We organized 4 Eye Screening Camps for Free Cataract Surgeries during the year at 4 different locations where in a total of 722 Patients were screened and 227 were recommended for surgery out of which 131 went under Cataract Surgery. The Camps were conducted by M P Birla Eye Clinic, Kolkata and surgeries took place at their Hospital in Kolkata. We thank our CSR Partner Tirupati Vancom (P) Ltd. for taking care of cost of Surgeries.

Facilitating Eye Donation for Sightless: Our Club has been instrumental in arranging pair of Cornea Donation from Deceased Person which provides vision to 4 sightless Individuals by convincing the immediate family in coordination with MP Birla Eye Bank. We arranged 2 Eye Donation from Sudha Khemka from Sushila Parasrampur after their Death.

Thalassemia Awareness: Thalassemia Awareness Seminar was organized jointly by RCC Yuvis and the Interact Club of Adamas International School, in association with Desun Hospital on 1st July, 2025. The seminar was attended by over 100 students from Classes XI and XII, who actively participated and gained important knowledge about this genetic blood disorder.

7 members of the Club attended the Car Rally and Treasure Hunt on 28th December, 2025 to raise awareness and fight Thalassemia organized by Rotary Dist. 3291 jointly with Lions International.

On the occasion of World Thalassemia Day on 8th May, 2026 RCCY handed over 20 Wastebins to Eastern Railways today to be installed inside Howrah Station at various locations to keep the Station clean. Each Dustbin has stickers on all 4 sides with a Message for awareness about Thalassemia. It will also help in creating public Image of Rotary.

Cervical and Breast Cancer Awareness & Screening Camp: The Camp was held at Samaj Unnayan Kendra Premises at Baruipur in collaboration with Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Cancer Hospital on 18th December, 2025. The camp was a success, helping around 30 local women learn and empowering them to fight cancer without fear.

Health Check up Camp at Greenwood Sonata Housing Complex: Our club successfully organized a health Check up camp with a total of 119 registrations on 1st November, 2025. The services included ECG (35), Eye Check-up (90), Audiometry (70), BMD (107), PFT (89), Blood Sugar (119), Blood Pressure (119), and Doctor Consultation (75). The camp conducted by Narayana Health was attended by people of all age groups, including drivers, maids, watchmen, and others.

Rain Coat Distribution: Our Club distributed total 357 Rain Coats to needy people in different Areas during the year – to local Vegetable Vendors, local farmers Kids of our School GLS and to Van & Rickshaw Pullers.

Mosquito Net Distribution: Our Club distributed 50 Mosquito Nets to local farmers and Vegetable Vendors of Mankurghat Area, Bagnan, to give them protection from Mosquito borne diseases like Dengue and 50 Mosquito Nets were handed over at SPCI Joka.

Blankets Distribution: 50 blankets were distributed to the Outram Club staff in our RWM held at Outram Club & 100 blankets were distributed to the underprivileged at Mankurghat, Bagnan.

Muskaan: Bringing smiles on faces of Specially Abled Children :This year RCCY organized Sports for Specially Abled Children twice – One at BYC, Hindmotor having 200 Participants and another at Gourimata Udyan, Baghbazar having 100 participants. School Bags, T Shirts and Caps were given to all participants and Medals and Prizes were given to all the winners in the 24 sports Events specially designed for them.

Zindagi – Monthly Birthday Celebration of Girls of 2 Orphanages: This project of celebration of Birthday of Girls born in a particular Month has become a monthly affair and is very close to our Hearts. We are doing at CMS Girls Home, Hindmotor and SPCI, Joka.

This year we celebrated Birthdays of 82 Girls of CMS Girls Home, Hindmotor born in the months from July, 2025 to April, 2026 and 52 Girls of SPCI, Joka born in the months from July, 2025 to November, 2025 by cutting Cakes and giving Gifts to all Birthday Girls. Every time we distributed Chocolates, Frootis etc.

Muskaan: Bringing smiles on faces of Children :A morning Movie Show “Sitare Zameen Par” at Cinepolis Movie Hall was organized for the Kids and their Teachers of our own Green Leaves School. It was attended by 34 Kids and 7 Teachers.

Swanirbhar – Distribution of Rickshaw Vans to Vegetable Vendors: Cycle Rickshaw Vans were distributed to 3 underprivileged vendors at Hindmotor & to 5 underprivileged vendors at Belur to support self-reliance. The recipients were overjoyed and grateful. Our Club handed over a hand driven Tricycle to a handicapped person Mr. Kanti Bhagat at Hindmotor.

Pragati: Sponsorships to Girls for Vocational Courses :Our Club sponsored Ms. Saraswati Bera of CMS for 3 years B.Voc in OT technology from George Telegraph Institute on 12th July, 2025. Total fees for 3 Years will be 1,87,840/-

Happy School – Construction, Development, Renovation of School Infrastructure: Handed over 4 Ceiling Fans to SPCJ, Joka and 15 Ceiling fans to G.R.K.C. Mills High School. Supporting the project and helping create a more comfortable learning environment for the children.

A collaborative effort by five Rotary Clubs RC Belur, RC Calcutta Metrocity, RC Calcutta Mayfair, RC Calcutta Pointers and RC Calcutta Yuvis for the reconstruction of girl students' washrooms and school hygiene improvements, with future plans for building renovation and electrical upgrades was inaugurated by DG Dr. Ramendu Homchaudhuri at Shree Sharada Vidyalaya on 12th December, 2025. The school, with 120 students, celebrated the initiative, and DG announced ₹1 lakh for renovation.

Dist. 3291 in organizing the Puja Parikrama for 55 Senior Citizen Women on 29th September, 2025 and also distribution of New Sarees and an Umbrella to all of them.
