Support for Education – Professional Education

Support for Education (Construction of School) -

Glad to inform that the construction at School, Abul Kalam Academy, is completed in all respects and formal Inaugurations of the school will be held in the presence of School Children's once the schools re-open after Covid related relaxation.

Health & Sanitation 'Suchita' - Toilets

04.10.20 – The Club completed the construction and handed over the 20 toilets at Birlapur. The project was supported by Eastern India Rotary Welfare Trust.

Rtn Sanjay Pasari & Rtn Dilip Choudhary personally visited, verified & handed over the constructed structures to the needy families.

Health & Sanitation – Covid Relief & Awareness (Under Global Grant 2013288)

17.10.20 - Rotary Club of Calcutta Yuvis and Mayfair jointly distributed the Covid-19 related protective items at the Covid Designated Vishudhanand Hospital, Kolkata for use by the doctors involved in the fight against this pendemic by treating the Corona affected patients.

With the mission to protect the health warriors, we have provided Thermal Scanner Guns (3 pcs.), M-95 Masks (100 pcs.), Cloth Mask 2 layer (1000 pcs) (With Rotary logo branding), Nitrate Hand Gloves (500 pcs.), PPE Kits (50 sets) (With Rotary logo stickers), Hand Sanitizer (200 ltrs) (With Rotary logo sticker), Fogging Sprayer (3 pcs.) (With Rotary logo stickers)

Cloth Mask, PPE Kits, Hand Sanitizer and Fogging Sprayer had the Rotary logo stickers on them to help identify and enhance the Rotary Image.

18.10.20 – In Support for Frontline Govt. Workers - ANM, ASHA & WB Police, Other Non Medical workers like Waste Management, Crematorium Workers etc. we provided various Covid Relief Materials at the Local Government Run Hospitals and Primary Health Centres in the Nine Blocks of 24 Parganas (S), namely, Joynagar 1, Joynagar 2, Magrahat, Kultali, Pademerhat, Madhabnagar, Gosaba, Sankarpur and Mathurapur. The Materials provided included Thermal Scanners (18 Units), Disinfectant Sprayer (18 Units), PPE Kits (770 Units), Nitrile Gloves (4700 Units), N-95 Mask (950 Units), Cloth Mask (10000 Units) and Sanitizer (1950 Lts).

For promotion of Awareness large quantity of Covid related Printed Materials like Posters (26,000 Units), Handbills (70,000 Units) and Booklets (10,000 Units) were also provided. These are expected to be of great use during the Durga Puja festivities and subsequent celebrations.

An innovative Moving Tableau with Hand-Wash station was also launched which will move around local areas during

Durga Puja. This Tableau with Rotary logo and mention of Rotary name in the pre recorded awareness messages is expected to fetch good awareness and mileage to "Rotary Public Image".

Our Rtns Manoj Pasari, Pawan Jain, Harish Sekhsaria, Ashish Agarwal along with Anup and Kuldeep from Mayfair personally visited and handed over the material.

Health & Sanitation – Seminar on Breast Cancer (31.10.20)

A Breast Cancer Awareness Webinar with Dr. Neha Choudhury Agarwal of Narayana Super Speciality Hospital was organised jointly with R.C. Avayana. The Seminar started at 5 pm and continued till around 6 pm. Total Audience presents were 42+.

Puja Parikrama for Senior Citizens (23.10.20)

We participated as one of the lead hosts of the Puja Parikrama project where a group of 35+ Senior Citizens were taken to the selected Durga Puja Pandals on Maha Saptami with strict Covid Norms as guided by Kolkata Police. Food packets & cloths were also gifted to all the participating senior citizens,

The entire project has been showcased with Covid, Polio & Dengue Awareness banners.

Members' Get-together (24.10.20) – A Maha - Asthami Puja Adda for Members and their families was digitally organized on Zoom. Games & fun activities were part of the programme fully enjoyed by the participants.

Women Empowerment & Recognition – We acted as a Co-host to the Flagship Project 'Tejaswini" of R C Avayyana. The project involves gradation, recognition and felicitations of the Durga Pujas organized exclusively by the Women.

This year the entire project was covered thru Digital media. We also distributed food & Cloths to the poor and needy.

Nature Quiz – The Club plans a Eco-Achievers (Nature) Quiz Kolkata Editions on 05.12.2020 with Saevus in Loving Memory of Late Rtn.Murali. Rtn Murali had a special affection to this Quiz and had lead the Yuvis team in most earlier version of the annually organized event.

This Quiz will be totally in an online format over Zoom & Facebook. Any Indian National can participate in the Quiz as a part of family team, provided the criteria for team composition provided below is met.

Children studying in any accredited board, National or State, will be eligible for the Quiz.

OUR MAJOR RUNNING / PLANNED PROJECTS

Some larger projects which take a longer time to execute / complete and cannot be covered in one particular month (or sometimes in a particular Rotary year) are included under this heading.

A. UNDER GLOBAL GRANTS

- Eye Care GG# 1982538 for Rs. 3560900 with RC Hazelmere of UK for 3000 IOL Surgeries. We have completed almost 2400 surgeries out of this.
- Eye Care GG# 1990800 for Rs. 43,39,980 with RC Charlotte International of USA for 1000 IOL Surgeries and 1 OCT Machine worth Rs. 2800000/- at Rotary Beldanga Eye Hospital. OCT Machine have been installed and about 250 IOL surgeries have been executed so far.
- Covid Care GG# 2013288 for Rs. 27,75,000 with RC Sylhet Garden City of Bagladesh and RID 3310 of Singapore for fighting against the Pandemic Covid -19 by supporting 6 Rural hospitals with Combat Covid materials and awareness propaganda on Covid-19.
 - ## This Project is completed in October 2020 and report to Rotary International is expected to be submitted soon.
- Covid Care GG#2013253 for Rs. 37,00,000 with RC Sylhet Garden City of Bagladesh for fighting Covid crisis in Bangladesh. We are a foreign partner in this GG which is our 1st GG as a Foreign Partners.
- B. HOUSING (AMPHAN RELIEF) Our club has started working on our ambitious project, 'Ashiyana'. Under this project, we will be providing PUCCA houses to the Amphan affected people at Nagenabad, Sunderbans. As per our time tested process, Survey & screening of the beneficiaries have already been completed and 15 beneficiaries have been identified. Each beneficiary will be provided with an house measuring 196 sft at a cost of Rs 149990/- per house, out of which RCCY will be contributing Rs. 1 lakh per house and the balance will be contributed by the beneficiaries themself.
