

He then requested Honourable Club Secretary to conduct the business.


Honourable Secretary conducted the club business.


He also administered the rotary oath taken by **Ms. Piyali** and welcome **Rtn. Piyali Roy Palodhi** to a great journey of Rotary Services.

# **Sir Winston Leonard Spencer Churchill**

(30 November 1874 – 24 January 1965)

Winston Churchill, arguably Britain's greatest **Prime Minister** who lead the United Kingdom through the darkest hours of the Second World War (1940 to 1945) and again from 1951 to 1955.

He was awarded **Nobel Prize in Literature** in the year 1953 "for his mastery of historical and biographical description as well as for brilliant oratory in defending exalted human values"

- Effort
- Willingness to change
- Courage
- Endurance
- A strong moral compass
- A sense of humour
