

#### INVOCATION:


As requested by the President, respected Rtn. Sekhar Chatterjee led the National Anthem.


#### **CLOSING REMARKS:**

**February 23 marks** a momentous occasion - **Rotary's 119th Anniversary**. The day is also called World Understanding and Peace Day.

February 23, 2024

On February 23, 1905, during the first Rotary club meeting in room 711 of the Unity Building in Chicago, Paul Harris, Gustavus Loehr, Hiram Shorey, and Silvester Schiele met to talk about their personal experiences. Harris then unfolded his general plan for their club meetings.

This was the simple beginning of the world's first service club, the Rotary Club of Chicago. Little did Paul Harris and his three friends realize what they were starting then to be able to do business with people with good ethics and business practices.

It was created because of Harris' wish to capture in a professional club the same friendly spirit he had felt in the small towns of his youth. The Rotary name was chosen from the early practice of rotating meetings among members' offices.

Taking prides in the history, from one club that grew rapidly in Chicago, Rotary International now exists in over 200 countries and territories.

Rotary is a non-religious and non-political organisation. As such, it is respected by governments, the United Nations and religions of all types.

**World Understanding and Peace Day**
