Minutes of the RWM 2780 held at the Mahendra Smriti Sabhaahar RC Dumdum on 04.04.25 at 6.30 pm

ADDRESS:

President Rtn. Sanjib Roy called the meeting to order, extending a warm welcome to all members.



BEGINNING:

The meeting commenced with the National Anthem, led by Rtn. Sanchita Sarkar, at the request of the President.

- a) Advanced birthday greetings were extended to PP Rtn. Kumar Brata Ghosh for his birthday on April 5th. Members joined in the celebration.
- b) The receipt of the newsletters 'METRO VOICE,' 'CHAKA,' and 'LIGHT' from RC Calcutta Metropolitan, RC Calcutta, and RC Garden respectively, was announced.

- i) Global Grant Project for awareness, detection, and vaccination for cervical cancer at URMIMALA DEVI AGARWAL MEMORIAL is progressing well. He emphasized the necessity of having a doctor present onsite during the cervical cancer vaccination process.
- ii) Battery Operated Van Rickshaw Helping Grant Project is taking shape, with the necessary payment made to EIRWT.
- iii) The Clean Drinking Water Project for rural communities — PRANDHARA is progressing scheduled, with required machinery from Tata Chemicals Ltd already arrived and en route to the site.



iv) In collaboration with RC Dumdum, RCC Dipsankar Memorial Welfare Trust distributed 619 spectacles free cost to beneficiaries underwent medical check-ups at eye camps.

Finally, Rtn. Rupankar requested the President Elect and members to consider developing new active RCC and Interact clubs, as managing multiple projects by RCC Dipsankar Memorial Welfare Trust is becoming challenging.

b) As planned, Rtn. Anirudha Nag shared important information about Cyber Security in Daily Life. The session was enlightening for the members and included an extensive Q&A segment. Members engaged in the discussion and expressed gratitude for the insights shared, greeting Rtn. Anirudha with a resounding round of applause.
