Swarnendu Saha** and **PP Rtn. Julie Saha** attended, along with **Rtn. Suman's** partner, **Barnali**.

f) President briefed the members about attending the 'Prandhara' program at Rotary Sadan, where he collected two water purifiers. These



would be distributed to *Khudiram* Colony School and *Abdul Aziz* High School, Nadia, on September 19th.

DISCUSSION:

a) President discussed a district project to administer cervical cancer vaccines to girls aged 9-14. If the club wished to undertake this initiative, at least 20 girls would need to be identified, with each receiving two doses of the vaccine at a six-month interval. The cost per dose would be approximately ₹2,500.

b) Members decided to postponed **Rtn. Dr. Asitava Sur's** scheduled talk on basic Education and Literacy to a future meeting.

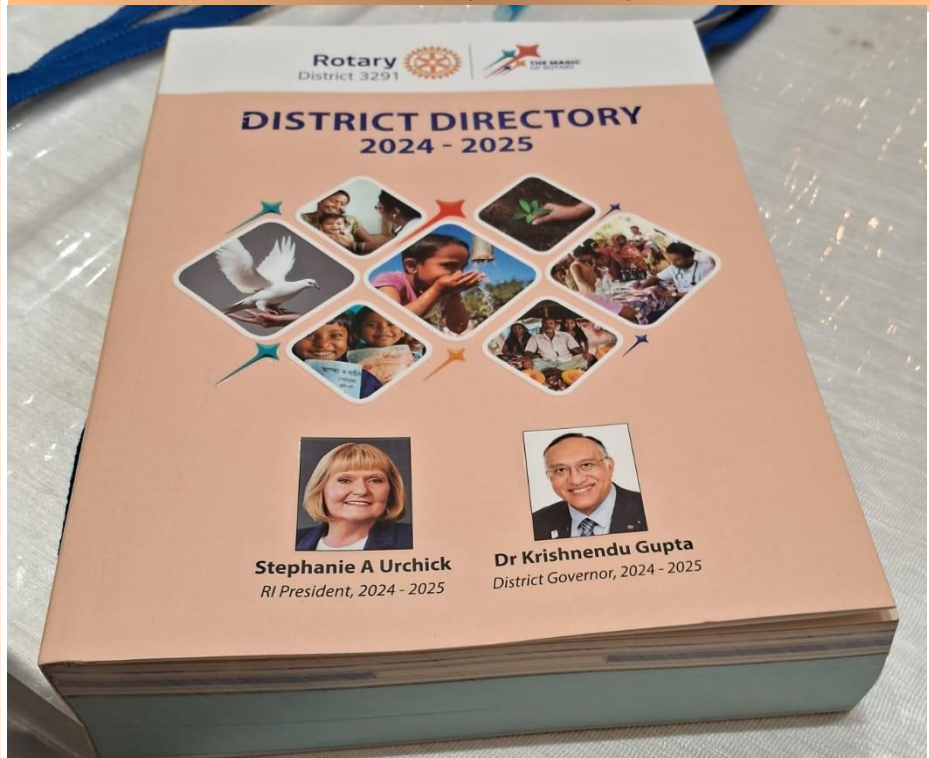
