ADDRESS:

c) Rtn. Rupankar outlined the following impactful projects that the club will undertake:

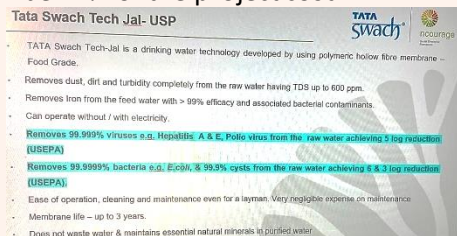
i) Global Grant Project: Awareness, detection, and vaccination for cervical cancer — URMIMALA DEVI AGARWAL MEMORIAL CERVICAL

CANCER (Project No. 2572076). This is a collaboration between RC Belur and RC Singapore Heartland, to be launched on March 23rd at Gangnapur Girls' High School in partnership with RCC Dipsankar Memorial Welfare Trust.



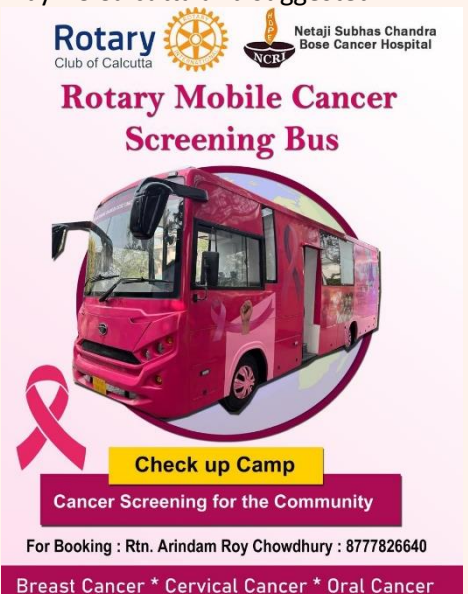
ii) Battery Operated Van Rickshaw Helping Grant Project (No. 0482): This project will assist five needy individuals, with a total cost of ₹3.0 lakhs. The Eastern India Rotary Welfare Trust has approved the project, and the club will contribute 50% of the total cost.

iii) Clean Drinking Water Project to the community in rural areas - PRANDHARA: In collaboration with RC Calcutta and Ncourage Social Enterprise Foundation (a subsidiary of Tata Chemicals Ltd.), this project has an estimated cost of ₹8.33 lakhs. The club's contribution will be 12% of the project cost.



DISCUSSION:

a) Upon request, DGN Rtn. Tapas Bhattacharya explained the Cancer Screening for the Community Project involving the ROTARY MOBILE CANCER SCREENING BUS by RC Calcutta and suggested



leveraging this unique facility to serve the community. Members expressed appreciation for the initiative.

b) The President announced that this year's CLUB SUVO NOBOBORSHO and HOLI MEET will take place on Saturday, April 19th, on a contributory basis. He also mentioned that some Rotarians from RC London are expected to join on that day, to discuss a School project at Ajodhya Hills, Purulia.
