It's a moment of pride for Belurians as our Global Grant project for Cervical Cancer Vaccination takes a significant step forward in Rourkela, invited by IFGL Refractories Welfare Trust.

Laying the foundation for this initiative, our Project Manager, Alokeparna Ghosh , visited Rourkela on Monday, 17th February 2025, conducting a comprehensive three-stage orientation program for 45 teachers. These trained educators will now lead parent-teacher meetings, ensuring strong community awareness ahead of the vaccination drive.

A special appreciation to Shraddhanjali, CSR Manager at Rourkela, for her unwavering support in making this program a success. The enthusiasm and commitment displayed by the teachers were truly commendable!

Looking ahead, a seven-member Rotarian team, including PDGs Ravi Sehgal and Mukul Sinha, will be traveling to Rourkela for the initiative. Project Chair Vishnu Dhandhania is spearheading the arrangements in close collaboration with our host, Rtn Rajesh Agarwal.
