



MAHISHASURAMARDINI, is a significant part of our cultural heritage. First broadcast in 1931, it was written by Banikumar, set to tune by Pankaj Mullick, and narrated by Birendra Krishna Bhadra. The oratorio featured songs by a galaxy of highly renowned singers that are still popular today. The programme is in Sanskrit and Bengali and has evolved into a harbinger of Durga Puja. The Pujas are deemed complete only when the programme is aired at 4 a.m. on Mahalaya.

Incidentally, this radio programme is the longest-running broadcast in the world.

It is a programme that has fostered a sense of inclusivity and equality, bringing people together in celebration. It also became a symbol of women's emancipation, and its makers famously stood up against caste and religious discrimination.
