An alumnus of Lady Brabourne College, Kolkata is a financial services professional with a flourishing career of over two decades. She co-founded Mumbai-based NGO Angel Xpress Foundation after volunteering at a street school in 2012.

Realizing the shortcomings of the education system for the underprivileged, Anubha sought to bridge the gap between socially conscious citizens and deserving children. Partnering with Beenaa Advani, a preschool owner, the duo initiated a social experiment to empower underprivileged communities through education and interactions. Starting with 18 children, the initiative has now grown into a movement involving 500 volunteers and 1900 children.

Despite challenges, her strong conviction in the impact of their work drives her forward. This year, a youth mentoring segment has been added to provide crucial guidance and training for sustainable employment opportunities. Anubha envisions uplifting underprivileged families into a life of dignity, as she believes dignity is a fundamental human right.


