A Level 2 Major Donor, his commitment to service has led to impactful projects that transform lives.

Pioneering the Transit Trauma Care Project

Dr. Homchaudhuri initiated the Transit Trauma Care Project in partnership with Kolkata Police and the Government of West Bengal. The deployment of 12 ambulances across accident-prone areas in Kolkata has saved countless lives by providing immediate emergency care during the Golden Hour.

A Visionary in Thalassemia Eradication

Recognized for his work in Thalassemia Awareness and Prevention, Dr. Homchaudhuri has conducted seminars, screening programs, and awareness campaigns across West Bengal, Assam, Odisha, and Bangladesh. His goal is to eradicate this 100% preventable genetic disorder through early screening and genetic counseling.

Transforming Lives in Rural Bengal

For the past three years, Dr. Homchaudhuri has been driving sustainable development in Dhaska, Purulia, alongside Hridham NGO. His contributions include:

Providing potable water through pond excavation and water conservation initiatives, Enhancing education for local children, Empowering villagers with incomegenerating activities to improve livelihoods.

In recognition of his service, Dr. Homchaudhuri was unanimously elected as District Governor Nominee and will assume office as District Governor of Rotary District 3291 in 2025-26. His vision includes expanding healthcare, strengthening education, and enhancing community welfare programs.

A Distinguished Medical Career







PP Rtn Dr Naresh Goyal also announced for making a Robotic Neuro-ortho Rehabilitation Centre in MSS, which probably the first of its kind in Eastern region. The idea was highly appreciated by everyone and to work out modalities for the implementation of the project.

Adding to the poignancy of the day were the performances by children with Cerebral Palsy, nurtured under the initiatives of MSS in collaboration with RCCM. Their vibrant display of music and dance, despite physical challenges, stood as a living example of resilience and joy.

What lingered after the formalities was not just pride in our country, but also gratitude for being part of a community that believes in lifting others, with every smile, every gesture, and every act of kindness.

Independence Day at Mahavir Seva Sadan was a reminder that freedom is not only about our nation's past struggles-it is also about the collective responsibility we hold today: to build an inclusive future where dignity, opportunity, and compassion reach all.



Dr. Vinod Kumar Nevatia was born on October 24, 1948, in Bathinda, Punjab. He completed his primary schooling in Batinda and later attended D.A.V. College in Abohar. Dr. Nevatia earned his M.B.B.S. and M.S. in Orthopaedics from Government Medical College, Patiala, Post graduating in January 1975.

After completing his senior residency at Willingdon Hospital (now Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital) in Delhi, Dr. Nevatia worked in Iran from 1977 to 1981. Upon his return to India, he settled in Calcutta and established his private practice.

MSS approached Dr Ashok Sengupta, a well-known Orthopaedic Surgeon as Patron of Mahavir International (Now Mahavir Seva Sadan) and told them to take young doctor for this work and recommended the name of Dr V K Nevatia. MSS approached Dr Nevatia and accepted to join 1985. He helped them to establish the workshop for the manufacturing of the Artificial limbs.

Dr Nevatia, a miracle worker and most Conscientious humanitarian. He has been involved in MSS since its inception i.e. more than 39 years. Even though he joined Rotary a few years later proposed by PP Rtn Dr Naresh Goyal, he has lived the life of a true Rotarian forever. He has been spearheading the Artificial Limbs

program since then and more than 4.00 lakhs limbs have been given, all with free replacement for life. Not just Artificial limbs but also hundreds of very complicated surgeries of Polio Corrective Surgeries. He has provided free consultancy services at various organizations, including Jyotirmai Club.

Just imagine, the number of lives which have been affected positively by him. He is volunteering 5 to 6 days every week for last 35 years in not just MSS but also on Shree Vishudhanand Hospital, Burrabazar and Shree Vishudhanand Saraswati Marwari Hospital, Amherst Street. The monetary value of the time he devoted professionally for service would amount to tens of crores.

Dr. Nevatia joined the Rotary Club of Calcutta Metropolitan in 2013 and served as President from 2022 to 2023. He is a multiple-time Paul Harris Fellow.

During his medical studies, Dr. Nevatia married Lata Nevatia on June 5, 1972. They have two children. Son Puneet happily married and settled in Boston, USA and daughter Suruchi happily married and settled in Dibrugarh.

Always eager and ready to support. Never say no to anything but bring solutions. A very cheerful doctor.

He was given President Scout by the President of India Dr Radhakrishnan in 1962.







DREAM, REALITY & BEYOND ON PROGRESS & ACHIEVEMENT OF MSS REHABILITATION & RESEARCH CENTRE, JOKA

On August 30, 2025, MSS Rehabilitation & Research Centre, Joka (a Unit of Mahavir Seva Sadan) presented its inspiring journey of transforming a vision into a world-class rehabilitation facility spread over 75,000 sq. ft. with modern infrastructure and state-of-the-art amenities.

Over the years, the Rotary Club of Calcutta Metropolitan has been closely associated with Mahavir Seva Sadan through impactful service projects such as Leg for the Legless, Rehabilitation of Post-Polio Syndrome Survivors, Rehabilitation of Cerebral Palsy children, providing tricycles and wheelchairs to the differently-abled, and scholarships enabling physically challenged students to pursue higher education.

A landmark initiative was the establishment of the Cerebral Palsy Children Rehabilitation Centre, made possible through a Rotary Global Grant exceeding ?75 lakhs, providing advanced equipment and therapeutic support to countless young beneficiaries.

During the event, President Emeritus Shri J. S. Mehta and President Shri Vijay Choraria highlighted the inspiring journey from dream to reality, and the vision of looking beyond with continued expansion. The project, with an investment of nearly ?39 crore (including land, building, interiors, therapy and lab equipment, artificial limb manufacturing units, residential facilities, and operational costs), stands today as a model institution for inclusive rehabilitation.

Project Engineer Ravi Dugger elaborated on the salient features of the centre, which includes:

- Climate resilience through elevated land development to safeguard from flooding.
- Inclusive design with ramps from ground to top floor for easy accessibility.
- Sustainability features such as sensory and healing gardens, rainwater recharge pits, and an STP system to recycle water.

Doctors at MSS showcased the latest advancements in artificial limb technology, where prosthetics are being developed to respond to neurological signals, thereby enhancing mobility and independence of beneficiaries.



The cultural program by especially abled children, cerebral palsy survivors, and prosthetic users was deeply moving, reminding everyone that true joy lies in creating smiles and empowering lives.

The event concluded with the inauguration of a new Audiology Centre, offering free check-ups, treatments, and hearing aids. MSS Patron Shri Vinod Kumar Bagrodia formally launched the initiative by presenting a hearing aid to a beneficiary on stage.

Among the distinguished Rotarians who graced the occasion were PP Rtn Dr V K Nevatia, PP Rtn Rakesh Kumar Goel, PP Rtn Harsh V Rungta, PE Rtn Runjhun Gupta, and Rtn Poulomi Dutta, reaffirming Rotary's continued commitment to service above self.




PLC - INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION
