MEGA HEALTH CAMP

On 2nd July 2023, the Rotary Club of Calcutta Presidency organized a **Mega Health Check-up Camp** focused on Mother and Child Welfare at a school in Gangacheri, Sonarpur. The camp encompassed several areas of healthcare.

Gynecology and Menstrual Hygiene Awareness 62 women underwent check-ups led by Dr. Pamela Ghosh, the Rotary District Maternal and Child Health Care Chair, and Dr. Rina Malpani, the Rotary District Co-Chair of the committee. Additionally, sanitary napkins were distributed to all the women.

Thalassemia Awareness Campaign

Dr. Bandana Roy Choudhury, the Rotary District Advisor to the Maternal and Child Health Committee, conducted a talk on the importance of breast milk and raised awareness about Thalassemia .

Pediatrics

Dr. Madhumita Roychoudhury and Dr. Bandana Choudhury provided check-ups and advice to 98 registered children, ensuring each child received individual attention and care.

Nutrition Advice

Nutritionist Rtn Sangita Jain, offered nutrition advice to all the women

present, who expressed satisfaction and promised to implement the suggestions in their daily lives.

Eye check up

A team of six professionals from the Dakshin Barasat Rotary Eye Hospital conducted eye check-ups for 60 individuals. Power glasses were recommended for 22 women and children, while three older women were advised to undergo cataract surgery, which the Rotary Club committed to providing. Which were sent later to the beneficiaries.

Blood tests for Blood Sugar and Hemoglobin were conducted, with 22 individuals participating.

During the camp, toffees, juice, and biscuits were provided, and after the check-ups concluded, a full meal was served to all 200 attendees.

The team of doctors received plants as tokens of appreciation. The medical staff from the eye hospital were felicitated with gifts.

Also celebrated Doctors Day and CA days – felicitated accompanying Doctors and CAs with gifts and boomerangs on a lighter note.

The event was attended by 12 members of the Rotary Club of Calcutta Presidency, and their exceptional teamwork was acknowledged.

WHY THE ROTARY WHEEL?

The first design was made by Chicago Business Magazine Press, an organization who drew all kinds of designs with a few days to spare and did, indeed, "The world was sure to flourish... (Publicity and Movement)".

After all the early days and some time of design school for publicists and journalists in 1912, it was decided that all Rotary Clubs should feature a single design as the emblem of Rotarians. Thus, in 1913, the present gear wheel, with 34 spokes and six gears was adopted by the "Rotary International Association".

A group of engineers advised that the gear wheel was mechanically sound and would not work without a "kernel" in the center of the gear's shaft. So in 1913 the kernel was added and the design, which we now know was formally adopted as the official Rotary International emblem.



Rotary is a vast machine, and the gearwheel is a hardworking gear, truly emblematic of the Rotary community working together for the service of mankind.
