About Rotary Club of Calcutta Renaissance :

The club (ID: 72076) was chartered on 22nd February 2006 by a group of Ex-Rotaractors to serve the humanity. The club was sponsored by Rotary Club of Calcutta, the oldest club in Asia. The club has done magnificent projects through the years in the form of donating Ambulances, Cervical Cancer Screening Van, Equipments for Eye Hospital, etc. The Club's signature projects include J4U, Light a Smile, Flight of Fantasy, Model Village Development at Paushi, Wash-in-Schools, Cycle Rickshaw Van Distribution, Sanitary Toilets besides various Entrepreneurship Development Programmes.

About Tushar (Rimpy) Maheshwari

Rtn. Tushar (Rimpy) Maheshwari was the elder son of Rtn. Asha and Rtn. Dr. Mahesh Maheshwari, both dedicated individuals being part of Rotaract in early 70's and Rotary for last four decades. Born on 28 December, 1976, Tushar spent his life in and around Kolkata and commenced his initial schooling from Auxilium Convent, Bandel, Dist Hooghly. Tushar lived a very simple life filled with empathy, honesty and respect for all without any discrimination, be it social or economic barrier.

Inspired by his family values and tradition, Tushar (Rimpy) joined as a member of Rotary club of Calcutta Renaissance on 3rd March 2010. During his career span as an Investment & Property consultant, he had successfully imbibed the Rotary's 4-way test while performing his professional activities and day-to-day personal life. Tushar married Shweta Maheshwari, a resident of Kanpur (UP) on 9 December, 2005, who herself was a successful homemaker and a rising entrepreneur.

The Kedarnath Incident

In June, 2013, Tushar along with Shweta and 13 other close family members belonging to Shweta (total 15 members ranging between 5 years to 75 years) visited Shri Kedarnath Dham to seek blessings. However, 16th June, 2013 onwards, there was torrential rainfall which led to multiple cloud bursts over the next 24 hours, with the most severe one of bursting of Basuki Tal Lake, located at North-east of Shri Kedarnath Dham on 17th June, 2013 (early morning). This led to a severe natural calamity in the contemporary history of mankind. Lakhs of pilgrims who had come from across India for their pilgrimage for the Char Dham Yatra (most particularly at Shri Kedarnath Dham then) bid their last farewell. In this sequence, all 15 members of four generations belonging to four branches of the same family, which included our dearest Tushar and Shweta, also left for heavenly abode.

The background of the Rolling Trophy

Tushar Maheshwari was a dynamic, young member of Rotary Club of Calcutta Renaissance who along with his wife Ann Shweta and other relatives were washed away by the ill-fated flash flood of 2013 during the Kedarnath Yatra that left thousands dead and missing. While the cruelty of destiny took him away forever leaving our heart broken, yet he remains in our heart immortalized through his good deeds while serving in Rotary.





To recognize and felicitate an exemplary Rotarian on the basis of 4-way test, his father, also a Rotarian for several decades Dr. M.K. Maheshwari has come forward to institute this Rolling Trophy in the annual calendar of our Club starting 2025-26.

Tushar & Shweta Maheshwari Memorial Rolling Trophy on Rotary's 4-way Test for the Rotary Year 2025-26 is being instituted for the first time in our Club for ones immense contribution to the cause of Rotary.

About the 4 - Way Test in Rotary

4-Way Test is still young and vibrant as it was in the 1930's. Herbert J. Taylor, a Chicago based Rotarian propounded this 24 words magic test not to present in any thesis or in any speech, but to save his own ailing company. Herbert J. Taylor says that "one day in July 1932 I decided to pray about the matter and asked God to give us a simple guide to help us think, speak and do what was right. I immediately picked up a white card & wrote out the 4-Way Test of the things we think, say or do as follows"

- 1. Is it the TRUTH?
- 2. Is it FAIR to all concerned?
- 3. Will it build GoodWill & BETTER FRIENDSHIP?
- 4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?

Herbert J Taylor further says that "constant use of 4-Way Test caused us to change our policies covering relations with competitors, we eliminated all adverse or detrimental comments on our competitors, products etc."

He further describes that " when we found an opportunity to speak well of our competitors, we did so. With this we gained the confidence and friendship of our competitors".

"The application of the 4-Way Test to our relations with our own personnel and that of our suppliers and customers helped us to win their friendship and goodwill. We have learned that the friendship and confidence of those with whom we associate is essential to permanent success in business".

In 1954-55, when HERBERT became Rotary International President, he presented the copyright of the 4-Way Test to Rotary International.

Rtn. Binod Khaitan - is a Past President of Rotary Club of Central Calcutta. He was District Secretary -Projects & Program for Rotary Years 1998-99 & Millennium Year 1999-00. He has been DISC, DGSC & District Stewardship Chair of RID 3291 for several years, for reason of his knowledge and dedication in furthering Grant programs of TRF. From 1997 to 2020 he was a Trustee and Trustee Secretary of The Eastern India Rotary Welfare Trust, through which RI District - 3291 set up it's Dream Project – Hospital at Sector V, Salt Lake, Kolkata. He is known for his outstanding work in the Villages of Hooghly District through RI's Program – Rotary Community Corps. He has been involved with a couple of 3H Grants and many TRF Grant Projects and is associated in the setting up of several Eye Hospitals in Eastern India. Since 2002-03 he is actively involved in spreading Rotary Leadership Institute in South Asia. RLI International has appointed him Vice Chair, RLI South Asia Region since 2006-07 to 2022-23. He is now

Rtn. Binod is a third generation Rotarian. Though he attended several meetings, projects & programs of RC Calcutta with his grandfather since 1956, he joined Jaycee & later Lion's Club while staying in Delhi. He joined RC Central Calcutta in 1988 at

the behest of PDG Saral Deb. His wife, Ann Chandrakala & he are Major Donors Level IV and a Benefactor. All his family members including grand children are PHFs and his son Sakate is also a Rotary Foundation Benefactor. He is an enthusiastic propagandist of the Rotary Foundation. He is the recipient of TRF's Distinguished Service & Meritorious Service Awards. He is listed in the Rotary Global History Fellowship (RGHF) as a Rotary Hero. He has been conferred a Life Time Achievement Award for his outstanding contribution and service to the Community & Rotary. He has attended eleven RI Conventions held at Singapore, San Antonio, Chicago, Copenhagen, Birmingham, New Orleans, Lisbon, Sydney, Seoul, Hamburg and Singapore recently. He is the first Patron of the 4 Way Test Association in India & the first member of Rotary Global History Fellowship in Asia.

Rtn. Binod has been associated with the Plywood, Tea, Jute, Fertilizer, Tyre tube and Soft Drink Industries. He has represented these industries in various Trade and Research Associations.

Rtn. Binod is a philanthropist and is associated with several Charitable Trusts and Organizations. A lover of natural surrounding, he is a keen Golfer and has represented the country. He was the first National Junior Golf Champion and has been the Chief Referee during the Indian open Golf Championships held at the RCGC.
