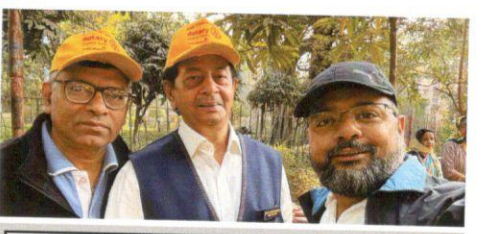

## Celebration of World Polio Day



RC Calcutta Renaissance had organized the Celebration of World Polio Day on 24th Oct 2025 held at Rotary Sadan from 3:30 Pm to 7:30 Pm as the District Event for RID 3291. All total there were 47 Clubs from the District participated as Lead Host, Host and Co-Host under the guidance of PDG Rtn Uttam Ganguli, End Polio Now Coordinator of Zone 6 and PDG Rtn Mukul Sinha, District Polio Plus Committee Chair.

120 Interactors were in attendance along with representatives from the participating clubs and district officials making the total head count to 240+. The event was widely covered by Friends 91.9 FM as official Radio Partner.

India has been Polio free since 2014, hence the celebration started with the beats of Dhaak played by a group of lady Dhaaki under Bengal Creative Council from Bongopon. The key note speaker were Dr. Amitalaha Sarkar, State Surveillance Medical Officer, West Bengal WHO India, NPSN (World Health Org, India) along with Rtn. Uttam Ganguli and Rtn. Mukesh Sinha.

The whole mission of the program was to achieve the target of polio Free World under Rotary International's program end Polio Now. Rotarians donated whole heartedly during the event and 20 Rotarians were presented the Polio Plus Society Pin. Two of the Interactors addressed the audience well. Tayyaba Bint Jamil of St John's Diocesan Girls Higher Secondary School spoke in English and Sreya Paul of Children's Welfare Association High School for Girls spoke in Bangla. The surplus from the proceeds of the program will be utilized solely for Polio eradication programs. Vote of thanks was given by Rtn Mukul Sinha and Rtn Sanjeeb Gandhi.
