# Club in Action in December PROJECT AT RCC KANTHALBERIA







## PROJECT AT RCC BRINDAKHALI



Blankets, mosquito nets and nylon bazar bags were distributed on 20th December, 2020 at RCC Brindakhali to 40 old and needy people of the village. A team of members headed by President Gayatree Dhar, Club Secretary PP Seema Danda, PP Vinita Dutt, Sutapa Das, Sudipta Sen and Subhadri Chatterji went for the project. This place is a remote village in South 24 Parganas. Few years ago four basic Indian toilets were built there but they are not in usable condition any more, as they were destroyed during Amphan. It was decided that we would help them to renovate the toilets and since the children of the village are deprived of any entertainment or activities, we will partner them in a Spotrs event in January 2021.

# Words of Wisdom: The Inspirational Art

On Saturday, 19th December 2020, guest speaker Shri Prateek Raja spoke on Inspirational Art. He calls himself an experimenter and along with his wife Priyanka runs two art galleries in South Kolkata which have received excellent reviews. He shared his screen and took the members through his galleries (virtual visit) and focused on a series of four simultaneous exhibitions in one space – a symphony of sounds (Dhvani). This was referred to as 'encountering four positions'.

The four solo exhibitions were of Late Krishna Reddy, French artist Julien Segard, Bangladeshi artist Ayesha Sultana and Rathin Barman from Tripura.

Late Krishna Reddy's work perfected a balance between technique,philosophy and vision – resulting in mastery of his medium. He invented the multicolour viscosity technique in painting which is very challenging and his work depicted simultaneous relationships between multiple discipline like drawing, print making and sculpture providing an insight into his magical world that stands out as a quest in simultaneity. Unfortunately he did not get the recognition that he deserved. His learning was at Shantiniketan and later in Paris. He was a student of Ramkinkar Baid and Nandalal Bose.

Some of artist Julien Segard's enchanting work was shared on screen.One that stood

out was titled 'Dark was the Night', engulfing the entire room it was exhibited in. In the layered folds of the work lay the betrayal of darkness disguised as light, the work installed in folds like a curtain depicting paradoxical nature of lightness and weight.

Space and form is central to Ayesha Sultana's project, 'Pulse' Her interest is in abstraction. Water dropping from almost a closed tap and then splashing on to a surface – that moment captured and encompassed in her sculpture. Drawings, sculptures in brass, wood and paintings were displayed to conceal than to reveal in her art form. She works with vibrant colours.

Rathin Barman is interested in architecture. His creative work visualises our urban landscape.His exhibits titled 'Dimensional Distortion' were a series of sculptures where wood, concrete, various construction material, brass, iron etc. had been used. An imposing concrete wall structure inlaid with brass, forms drawing of a home which he envisaged from interviewing people who lived in grand old homes and left behind past grandeur of a large structure to move into modular forms of housing.. From their narrative arose his vision of the exhibit.

The four solo exhibitions presented together offered an insight into each artists singular practice, yet allowed spillages in each exhibit to cross over the other's space. Prateek Raja mentioned that because of the unusual times, he is currently holding talks and shows on line. He also invites curators from all over the world to share space and ideas. He has also devised young adult's learning programmes. Shri Prateek Raja was introduced by Sudipta Sen and thanked by Kashmiri Marwah.
