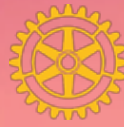

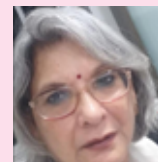

## Report on Management Development Program at IIM Calcutta



The Indian Institute of Management Calcutta conducted a Management Development Program for Rotary Presidents-Elect (2026–27), along with Assistant Governors (AGs), district officials, and several Past District Governors (PDGs) on Sunday, the 15th March 2026.

The program was a full-day session, divided into two major segments. The first half focused on Team Building and Collaboration, followed by sessions on Developing Conflict Management Skills (Part I & II).

Professor Amit Dhiman led the initial session on “What Makes a Team Work and Its Complex Challenges.” He emphasized that effective team building requires:

▶ A clearly defined task that necessi-

tates collaborative effort and cannot be achieved individually

▶ Clearly established boundaries identifying team members and non-members

▶ Adequate authority for team members to manage and integrate their work

Professor Dhiman also introduced the Belbin Team Role Inventory. Participants completed a structured assessment comprising seven sections with eight statements each, designed to evaluate individual contributions within a team. The exercise highlighted various dimensions of teamwork, including project roles, backup roles, primary team functions, and potential areas of weakness.

The second half of the program was conducted by Professor Rajiv Kumar, who spoke on Developing Five Styles of Handling Conflict. He explained that conflict exists at multiple levels—within individuals, between individuals, among groups, across organizations, and even between nations, as is evident in the current global context. He

stressed that both personal behavior and environmental factors play a significant role in managing conflict. The session covered five primary conflict-handling approaches: integrating, dominating, obliging, avoiding, and compromising.

Conclusion:

The program underscored the importance of maintaining a calm and composed mindset while dealing with conflicts, regardless of the approach adopted. Effective leadership lies in choosing the appropriate style based on the situation while fostering collaboration and mutual understanding.
