*India's literacy rate is 77.70%. (Source: National Statistical Office India, 2021)

*99.09% of children in India between the age group of 6-14 years are enrolled in school. (Source: UNESCO)

*There are 18.12 crore non-literate Adults in India (13.13% of India's total population) India houses highest number of adult non-literate in the world

*India can become totally literate when its adult nonliteracy is eradicated. i.e, becomes literate and only then the literacy rate will rise beyond 90%.

RILM's Adult Literacy Program (Education for all) aims to impart functional literacy to non-literate adults (15+ age) across India towards increasing national literacy rate beyond 90%.

- President Rtn Sayan Mukherjee took the chair and called the 2713th RWM to order and requested PP Rtn.Ajoy Kumar Sarkar lead the National Anthem.
- President wished Happy Birthday to Ann Dr Mrs. Radha Khan(14Sept).
- President reported about District program 1st President, Secretary, AG, ZS& District team meet is going on 14&15 Sept'24 at Hotel Sonar Bangla ,Mayapur.
- President reported about Menstrual Hygiene program held at three different girls' school-Nandannagar Girls high school, Jatindas Nagar Girls High school and Belghoria Deshopriya Vidyaniketan for Girls. Ann Dr. Mita Ghosh addressed the girls about Menstrual hygiene. Total 5500 sanitary napkins were handed over to the School authorities for use of the girls.
- President made the following announcements-a) Tree Plantation in around Belghoria. President reported that Kamarhati Municipality provided 25 saplings. Another 100 saplings will be available from District source. He proposed to involve local clubs so that they can look after the plants, watering those. Both Rotary's name and the clubs name will inscribed on level. Tree plantation will be taken up on 21 & 26 Sept'24. He also proposed to involve School students in this program so that it can also be projected as Easy School program b) Installation of new Interact Club's new committee will held on 31 Sept'24.
- President proposed to give new clothing to differently able persons of Prapti like previous years. Prapti Secretary was contacted by our Club Secretary. It will not be possible to bring all the physically challenged beneficiaries to our venue in the evening. So either we go to their organization office or some selected persons will come to our Club and the items will be handed over to them.
- PP Rtn. Ratna Ghosh raised a point regarding getting Computers, water filters by Vidyaniketan School from other sources. These matters were not informed to members through Whattsapp group or in any meeting. So that others could also applied for that. Secretary Rtn Amit replied that these programs are of RC Calcutta. They ask for beneficiaries from different clubs. Regarding PCs it was discussed in meeting that those will be installed at Vidyaniketan School so that our Vocational training program can be carried out over their with the help of their Computer teachers. Regarding Sewing machines and Wheel chairs no names in particular yet recommended, RC Calcutta may provide us 4 sewing machines.
- Being requested by President, Secretary Amit Kr Bhattacharyya conducted the Club business and got the minutes of last RWM confirmed proposed by PP Rtn.Ajoy Kumar Sarkar and seconded by PP Rtn.Sunil Kumar Biswas.
