VACCINE PREVENTABLE DISEASES AND ADULT VACCINATION :

Adults may be susceptible to outbreaks of vaccine-preventable diseases (VPDs) due to a number of reasons, including: lack of adult immunization, waning immunity, age-related factors, and epidemiological shift.

The CDC recommends the following vaccines for adults:

COVID-19: At least one dose of the current vaccine

Influenza/Flu: Every year

Tdap/Td: 1 dose of Tdap, then a Td or Tdap booster every 10 years

RSV: If pregnant during RSV season, or if aged 60 - 74 years

Measles, mumps, rubella (MMR): One or two doses depending on indications,

Varicella (VAR): Two doses, if born in 1980 or later
Beside above vaccines Indian National CDC also recommends following vaccines :

Human Papillomavirus (3 doses females) *

Pneumococcal (1 or 2 doses, then 1 dose every 5 years)

***Hepatitis A (2 doses) *Hepatitis B (3 doses)**

***Meningococcal (1 or more doses)** India has made significant progress in increasing immunization coverage, reducing child mortality, and combating VPDs. The country's commitment to immunization is reflected in initiatives like the Universal Immunization Programme, Mission Indradhanush.
