Human papilloma virus (HPV) is a group of over 200 related viruses, some of which are sexually transmitted. Most HPV infections are harmless and clear up on their own, but some types can cause genital warts or certain cancers. There are both low-risk and high-risk HPV types, with high-risk types being associated with various cancers. HPV types 16 and 18 are the most common high-risk types, responsible for the majority of HPV-related cancers like Cervical Cancer. Other high-risk types include 31, 33, 35, 39, 45, 51, 52, 56, 58, and 59. Low-risk HPV types, like HPV 6 and 11, are the main cause of genital warts.
