Dear Rotarians, and friends,

In 1925, Dr. Thomas Benton Cooley walked into a land where children were dying of anaemia .Iron was given— because that is what medicine believed. But instead of improving, the children worsened. That moment changed history. It led to the discovery of **Thalassemia**— not a disease of deficiency, but a disease of inheritance. Today, we know the truth.If both parents are carriers, there is a 25% chance that a child will be born to suffer. But if a carrier marries a non-carrier— Thalassemia will never occur. So the question before us is no longer medical. The question is—are we ready to act? For decades, we have focused on treatment: Repeated blood transfusions... lifelong dependency... Iron overload, complications, suffering.Children become Tied to transfusion... tried by treatment... and tired of life And as a nation, we exhaust millions of units of precious blood every year.Yet the truth is simple.

Thalassemia is 100% preventable. Still, we hesitate.We hesitate to speak about: Right choice of partners Premarital testing Prenatal decisions We remain confined in a cocoon of inertia.

My dear friends, History teaches us something.For nearly 200 years, our nation remained under foreign rule. Not because we lacked strength— but because we lacked awakening. The real battle was not outside... it was within.And when that awakening came, through courage and social leadership— history changed.Today, I ask:Are we facing a similar inertia in our fight against Thalassemia? Is it not a social responsibility when we knowingly allow children to be born into suffering despite having the knowledge to prevent it? Has our societal warning system weakened,when a sacred institution like marriage can unknowingly become a pathway to tragedy? This is not about blame.This is about awakening.It is time to move from horoscope to microscope. A simple HPLC test—costing less than a meal—can prevent a lifetime of suffering. A carrier can safely marry a non- carrier But two carriers must act responsibly Early screening, informed decisions, even adoption— these are not weaknesses, but wisdom

- President Rtn. Amit Kumar Bhattacharyya took the chair and called the 2783rd RWM to order and requested. PP Rtn. Dr. Sanjit Mukherjee to lead the National Anthem.
- In absence of Secretary, Rtn Rohit Goel was requested to perform the duties of Secretary.
- President informed about 3rd Presidents, Secretaries, Assistant Governors(Admin) and Zonal Secretaries meet "RENDEZVOUS II" is on 25th April'26, Saturday at 7-00pm at "HALDIRAM BANQUETS, BALLYGUNGE.
