The training session was attended by 60 college students, 2 professors, and 4 Rotarians. The event aimed to equip participants with essential lifesaving skills through hands-on CPR training. A professional trainer from USV conducted the session, covering key aspects of CPR, including: The importance of immediate response in cardiac arrest cases. Step-by-step demonstration of CPR techniques. Hands-on practice sessions for students and faculty members. The role of bystanders in emergency medical situations. The interactive session allowed students to engage actively and practice CPR techniques under expert guidance. The CPR training program was successfully conducted, leaving a significant impact on all participants.
