The Club Leadership Plan (CLP) can be customized to fit the needs of every Rotary Club. Under the CLP, there are five standing committees that report to the Board. The Board as per Article 10, Section 4 of the standard constitution of the Rotary club comprises the President, IPP, President Elect and Secretary, and may include one or more Vice President. All of whom shall be member of the BOARD. The Treasurer and Sergeant-et-arms may be member of the Board if the Bye laws so provide.

The standing committees are:

- 1 .Club Administration- The committee conducts activities associated with the effective operation of the club
- 2. Membership: The committee develops and implements a comprehensive plan for the recruitment and retention of members.
- 3. Public Image: The committee develops and implements plans to provide the public with information about Rotary and promotes the club's service projects and activities.
- 4. Service Projects: The committee develops and implements Educational, Humanitarian and Vocational projects that address the needs of its community and communities in other countries.
- 5. The Rotary Foundation: This committee develops and implements plans to support The Rotary Foundation through both contributions and program participation. Additional committees or Subcommittees may be added to suit the special interest of the club or ongoing projects.
