The Rotary India Literacy Mission

(RILM), formerly known as Rotary South Asia Society for Development and Cooperation (RSAS) aims to work towards Total literacy and Quality Education in India. To achieve that RILM have designed a comprehensive program called "T-E-A-C-H" where :

T - Teacher Support The aim of the Teacher Support program is to improve the professional skills and performance of teachers through training/re-training and recognition to outstanding teachers

E - E-learning : "E-Shiksha" is the program is a single classroom installation through an integrated solution consisting of a LCD projector / LED TV / Smart LED TV loaded with the educational audio-visual software mapped with State curriculum in local languages "E-Shiksha", aims at improving the teaching-learning experience through the use of curriculum based audio-visual modules

A - Adult Literacy :RILM has set a goal of making 5 crore adult literate by the year 2027. Nav Bharat Shiksha Karyakram of Government of India where the government has planned to make 5 crore adults literate by 2027. Government of India and RILM, together plan to make 10 crore adults literate by 2027. The term Adult Education is to be replaced with 'Education For All

C - Child Development : Every child has got right for his/her education. School dropouts or the child who never attended a School can be brought back through a RILM program Asha Kiran by sponsoring a child.

H - Happy School :Happy School Program aims to provide/upgrade the infrastructural and co-scholastic facilities in state funded schools, to make them secure, attractive and happy learning places for students and teachers. A positive and a cheerful school environment with all basic-infrastructure present can increase student enrolment, yield better attendance which leads to higher retention and improves concentration which leads to better learning outcome among students.

Club Programs Held

Report on last Board Meeting held on 3rd Sept'23 at Club premises. Discussed about following important points. a) Project Renovation of Submersible tube well of Uday villa School at the cost of Rs.25000/ with grants from EIRWT, School and club will contribute Rs6250/ each, b) in Menstrual Hygiene program will distribute 1000 sanitary napkin to two different schools. c) PRAPTI an organization of differently able persons will be given 60 T Shirts& Sharees during upcoming festive season. For this each member should contribute Rs 1000 each (minimum- if not more).

f) Installation of 2 new Split ACs immediately in our Club. One Ac will be donated by PP Rtn. Pradip Chaudhary another by members generous contribution. New meter already installed with increased load.

g) At last Club could manage a PAN and certified copy of Society registration of 1979.
