Upcoming Opportunities



Hence we all Rotarians have to take a pledge that we are ready to serve as a single unit.







Community Service

Rotary Club Belthangady organised over 9 blood donation camps in the taluk in association with various organisations. Blood banks from A J Shetty Hospital Mangalore, KMC Hospital Mangalore and Red Cross Mangalore collected over 1300 units of blood from these camps which is a record for the club and helped in saving lives of many people. Apart from camps, club has joined hands with Seva Bharathi, Kanyadi for a program named Rotary Seva Bharathi Jeeva Rakshak Project for arrangement of blood during emergencies and has arranged blood to over 40 patients undergoing one or the other critical treatments and surgeries.

Rotary Club Belthangady in association with various organisations and hospitals like SKDRP B C Trust, SDM Multi Specialty hospital, IDA Puttur Branch, Benaka Health Center, Shri Krishna Hospital Kakkinje, Yenepoya Medical College Hospital and Zulekha Yenepoya Institute of Oncology, KVG Dental College, Prasad Nethralaya has organised over 8 free health checkup, dental checkup, eye checkup and treatment camps across taluk and worked towards building a healthy society benefitting thousands of people.

Education and schooling were primary focus areas for the year 2024-25 for Rotary Club Belthangady. Government Higher Primary School, Karnodi which was renovated at a cost of over Rs. 30 lakhs, Toilet projects at Government High School, Kayarthadka built at a cost of over ₹14 lakhs, DKZP Higher Primary School, Navoor built at a cost of over ₹26 lakhs were handed over to the school. Construction of new 18,000 sqft block at Mundaje Aided High School built at a cost of over Rs. 2.25 crores, a signature project of Rotary year 2023-24 under the leadership of IPP Rtn Ananth Bhat M and IPS Rtn Vidyakumar K was completed during the period and handed over on 20th June 2025 with the grand inaugural ceremony graced by RI Dist. 3181 DG Rtn Vikramdatta, DGN Rtn Sathish Bolar, AG Rtn Mohammad Valavoor, District Secretary Rtn Rithesh Baliga and many Rotarians and locals.

All these projects were duly completed with help of generous donations from Rotarians of Rotary Club Belthangady, Rotary Bangalore Indiranagar and other clubs of District 3181, CSR funds from CanFin Homes, GI Auto Pvt Ltd., Laxmi Groups, MLC funds and local people.

Construction of 3 new toilet blocks at Governement School, Bayalu, Government High School, Kalmanja, Government School Killuru and 1 toilet renovation project at Government High School Bangadi has been commenced during the period with work in progress and due for completion soon. In order to promote digital literacy for students in rural schools, Rotary Club Belthangady joined hands with Nuware Systems LLP, Bangalore and donated over 32 computers to 12 Govt schools of the Taluk based on the strength of the students in the school. 2 new computers were donated to Block Education office (BEO).

Rotary Club Belthangady supported the education of economically backward & deserving students in a big way by donating books, bags, shoes and scholarship distribution which ensured students are not deprived of education due to poverty and monetary problems in the family. By organizing scholarship events we could cover students studying in both Government Colleges and Private colleges of Belthangady Taluk. In association with CanFin Homes Ltd and Rotary Bangalore Indiranagar over 400 meritorious students with more than 85% marks in SSLC and PUC were given scholarships worth Rs. 25,50,000/- which helped students pay fees, buy books and stationery.

In memory of great educator and visionaries Late Rtn Dr. B Yashovarma and Late Shri Vijayaraghava Padvetnaya organised an event called 'Yasho Vijaya' and distributed school bags and umbrellas to over 600 students of Govt Schools around Belthangady Taluk. Donated green boards to classrooms and shoes to over 75 students of Govt higher primary School Halepete. Distributed bags and stationery items to more than 100 students of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Awasiya School, Muguli Belthangady.

Joined hands with Rotary Bangalore Indiranagar and Rotary Mangalore Downtown to donate Steel Racks and Cupboards worth Rs. 1,25,000/- to 7 Anganwadi Schools of Neria locality. Also working towards renovation of around 10 Anganwadi Kendra's with the help of CSR funds.

Organised Menstrual hygiene programmes in schools and colleges for girls in association with Anns Club Belthangady and Rotary Bangalore Indiranagar. We could provide health and hygiene awareness to more than 800 girls of Govt schools, colleges and Private colleges by sessions conducted by renowned gynecologist Ann Dr. Vinaya Kishore and Subject Matter expert Rtn Sowmya Shrikanth. Distributed menstrual cups to Sanjeevini group and SHG members of various gram panchayaths and created awareness among women health and hygiene among rural women.

In a push to sustainable living and environment conservation Rotary Club Belthangady undertook many projects like Tree planting drives, seed and sapling distribution.

'Jala Nidhi' a signature project of Rotary Club Belthangady promoted paddy cultivation as helps in holding water and replenishing it to the ground thereby recharging local water bodies in the whole catchment area. People were asked to cultivate paddy in their land which holds water for over 3 months for one crop. This natural way of water conservation has yielded good results where by water levels has increased in wells, ponds and borewells of the vicinity by recharged ground water.

Complete renovation of Operation Theatre at a cost of Rs. 9 lakhs at Government Veterinary Hospital Belthangady was taken up with CSR funds from GI Auto Pvt. Ltd., Bangalore and completed the project at a record time of 2 months and handed over the facility for public use. This operation theatre now treats over 1500 dogs, cats every month.

'YuvaSiri', a two phase unique program organised by Rotary Club Belthangady in association with Baduku Katona Banni Seva Trust, SDM College Ujire – NSS unit where students and local people participated in paddy sowing, harvesting in the fields near Anantha Padmanabha Temple Ananthodi Belal with an objective of educating and motivating the younger generation to take up paddy farming

and passing them the know-how and techniques followed in paddy cultivation including the full cycle starting from ploughing, sowing, weeding, manuring and harvesting and also preserving our Tulunadu cultures and traditions. In this mega event over 5 acres of paddy field was sowed, harvested by more than 1500 students, volunteers and Rotarians thereby creating a World Record and registering the name of Rotary Club Belthangady in 'Golden Book of World Records'.

Construction of a house at a cost of more than Rs. 4 lakhs to single mother Smt Lalitha of

Gandhinagar, Ujire is in full swing and is expected to be completed soon. Rotary club Belthangady has

joined hands with various donors and organisation for this project.
