Former Chief Technical Officer At The Indian Navy,

enjoys doing community work. “After being in the navy for 15 years and travelling to many countries, I was drawn to Rotary in 2010, as its community service, fellowship and discipline attracted me,” he recalls. He is confident of inducting 300 new members, and chartering six new clubs taking the total number to around 4,000 and 95 respectively by June-end next year.

His pet project, Sandha Surakhsha (protection for elders), is providing medicines, recliner beds, mobility aids and western toilets to at least 1,000 elderly patients facing terminal illness, mostly in rural areas. “We are holding cervical cancer awareness sessions in 450 educational institutions. If the vaccine price comes down, then we will have vaccination camps too,” he says. RC Sullia will donate medical equipment (GG: ₹50 lakh) to a physiotherapy centre for special children; while RC Puttur will conduct mammography camps (GG: ₹35 lakh) jointly with a government hospital.

For TRF-giving, his target is

\$400,000. “We are continuing with nine big projects from last year,” he says.
