About Interact Clubs:

An Interact club is a youth service club sponsored by a local Rotary club, aimed at students ages 12-18 who want to develop leadership skills through community and international service projects. While Rotary provides guidance and mentorship, Interact clubs are self-governing and organize at least two service projects a year—one for their local community and one to promote international understanding. Interact is a part of the "family of Rotary," designed to empower young people and shape future leaders.

Key functions and goals

- Community and international service: Members carry out hands-on service projects in their local
 community and also work on projects that foster international understanding, such as global
 awareness initiatives.
- **Leadership development**: The program is designed to help members develop leadership qualities, personal integrity, and life skills like time management and financial literacy.
- **Global connection**: Interact has over 11,000 clubs in more than 145 countries, making it a global network dedicated to service and fellowship.
- **Mentorship**: Sponsored Rotary clubs provide support and guidance, offering mentorship to members and acting as a gateway to other youth programs and opportunities.
- **Future leaders**: Interact is seen as a pathway to future Rotarians, as it prepares young people for future leadership roles in their communities and the world.


