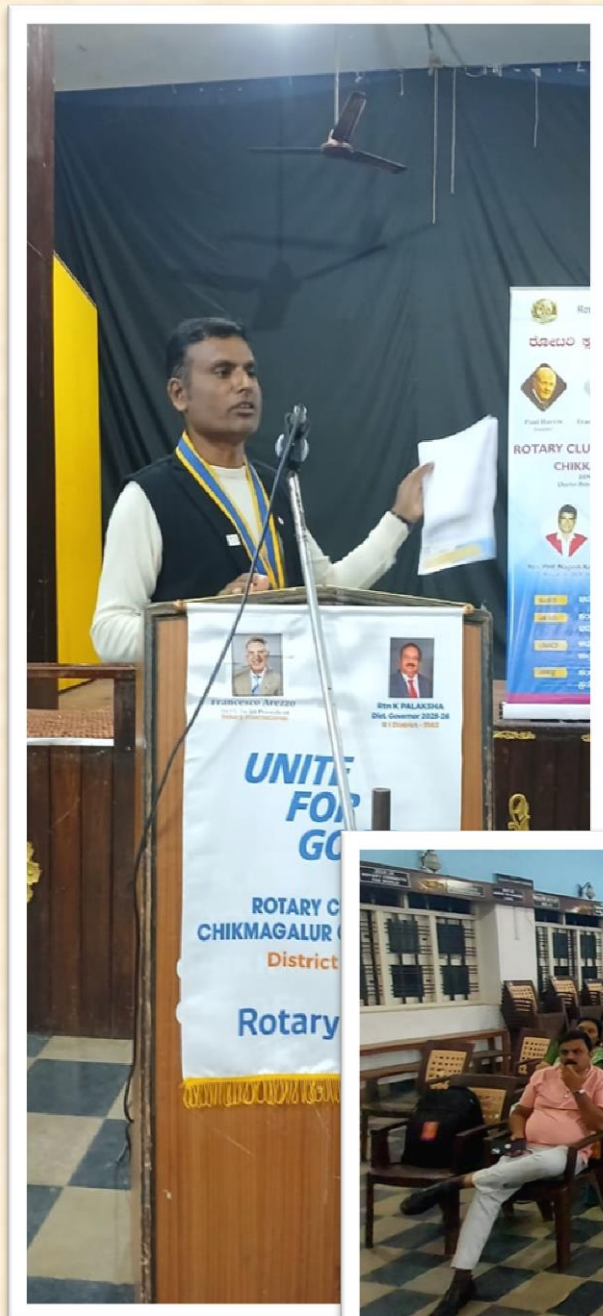
The 6th board meeting of the Directors of the Club was on 29th September 2025. The agenda was
