Dear Rotarians,

We welcomed Mr. Ramesh Babu N, DCF, Chikkamagaluru as the guest speaker in our weekly meeting on 2nd December 2025. Rtn. Sheik Ali introduced the guest to the club members.

Mr. Ramesh Babu talked about the Human - Animal Conflict in the overall theme of responsibilities of the Forest Department. He mentioned generally animals avoid humans. He listed out various situations where the human – animal contact may occur, the factors that may lead to injuries to humans. He also talked about the many initiatives taken by the Forest Department to reclaim the encroached forest land, avoid animal movements outside their habitat. He informed the club about the surprising behaviour of animals like deer and bison eating the bark of Acacia and Teak trees thereby damaging them also. Previously animals would not touch those trees. This is an example of adaptation (On the lighter side, it seems that they have acquired a taste for them).

In the Q & A after the talk, he patiently answered questions from Rotarians and explained various issues related to them. Overall it was an illuminating evening.
