In the 40th weekly meeting of our club, it was members' time where members discussed pending projects of the club.

One issue was the damage to the pillar in the Rotary Theme Park at Smt. Rukminiyamma Government Maternity Hospital due to sinking of land. The President assured the members that the issue is getting repaired and would be completed within a week.

Members highlighted the time that has passed since start of Rudrabhoomi project and were very much disappointed that it was not yet complete. Members acknowledged the work done till now under the chairmanship of Rtn. Suresh B.N, but were dissatisfied with the stoppage of work since long time without any updates to the club. President was questioned about the same. With various options discussed, members decided that the project should be

completed within a month and directed the President to do the needful, who mentioned that the issue would be taken up in the board meeting that was being held next day, on 1 April 2026. The members resolved that the past financial dealings related to work and material would be responsible of the Chairman of the project committee. The coming work should be handled separately.

Rtn. Manjula Devi had contributed to the Rotary Foundation to earn Paul Harris Fellow (PHF). The certificate and the lapel pin had arrived from Rotary International and was presented to her at the meeting.



On 1st April 2026, the 12th meeting of Board of Directors of Rotary Coffeeland was at the MLV Rotary Hall in TMS campus with the following agenda:

1. Rudrabhumi project status and future course.
2. 25th Charter year Celebration of our Club.
3. Tower clock project payment.
4. Accounts hand over to New Treasurer 2026-27

The President informed the board about the wish and direction of the members for completing the Rudrabhoomi project within a month that was resolved in the previous day weekly meeting. He informed the Board about the lack of information about the progress and status of the work and the financial accounts related to the project. He further mentioned that the project Chairman has not furnished any information in spite of repeated requests and reminders both physically, via mobile call and whatapp messages. Discussing all the matters, the board taking into consideration the wish of the club members decided that the President should issue a letter requesting information and giving 3 days' time to Chairman Rtn. Suresh to furnish them, failing which, the Club will take up the completion work of the Rudrabhoomi project and the previous works financial accounts and dealings would be responsibility of the Chairman himself. The Club will not be responsible for any issues.

This year being the 25th charter year of our Club, it was decided to celebrate the Silver Jubilee Charter Night in a grand way. The issue of financial requirement was taken up, it was informed that the joint board and this year's budget had not included the Charter Night celebrations and that was to be collected by the members separately. After much discussion, the charter night being the celebration of the club, all members are to compulsorily contribute Rs. 2,000/-. Further, the board made a strong recommendation for contribution to:

President: Rs. 40,000/-

Past / Present Assistant Governor: Rs. 25,000/-

Past Present Zonal Lieutenants: Rs. 15,000/-

Board Members: Rs. 5000/-

The charter night is tentatively planned to be on 10th May 2026. All members are requested to mark their calendar and participate in the celebrations.

The President informed that the Tower Clock that is planned to be installed in one of the traffic junctions in our town is complete and will be shipped once the payment is done. The board gave the permission to do the payment with proper documentation.

The President gave the accounts up to date to the new Treasurer Rtn. Nasir Hussein and informed the board that he would give the accounts for the year one month before the end of the Rotary year so that the next year team can start with a clean slate.

The following day, as per the wishes of the members and the direction of the Board, a letter was issued to Rtn. Suresh B.N about the intention of the club to complete the Rudrabhoomi project.

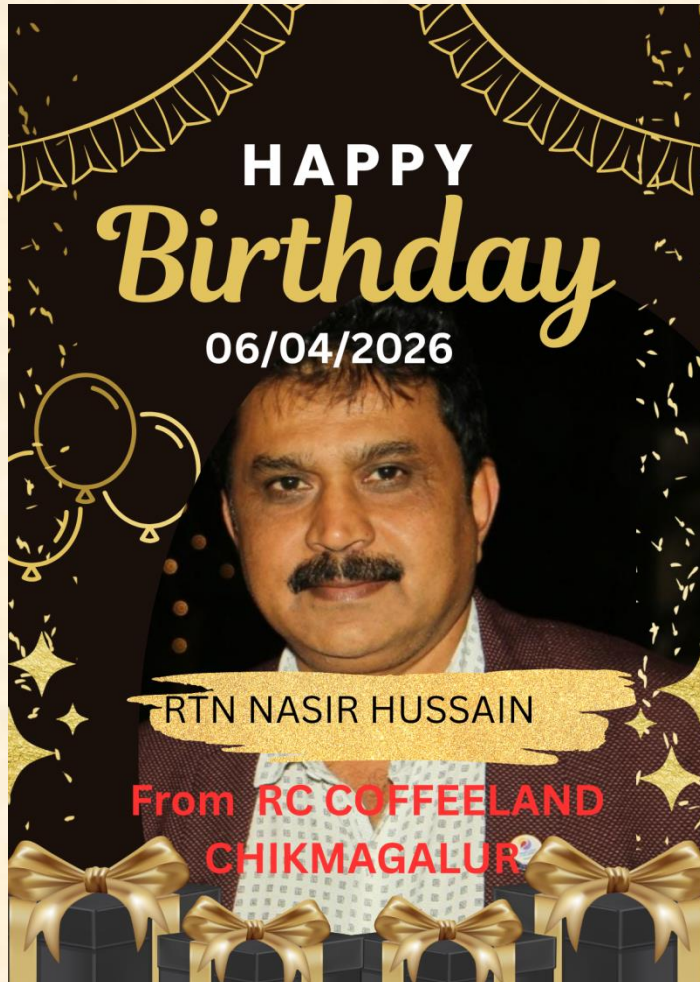
