Surprisingly, the whole building is powered with solar energy, they do not have a electricity connection. The hosts greeted the visitors with a delicious breakfast. Many thanks to them.









Next the team reached Hospete. They were welcomed by the Rotary Club Hospet. The drive members were show around their about 11 permanent projects at one place. There was a ICU ambulance, a primary school, dialysis center, a clinical laboratory, a clinic and blood bank were there was a special machine that only takes platelets from the donor while giving back the blood. This was an inspiring project for the visitors to see and interact with the host members about their organisation and operational structure

The visitors exchanged the flag with the host club and were treated with a yummy lunch.













After lunch, the thankful team departed to Bagalkote.


District Project on Education:






