Secretary Rtn. Latha proposed the vote of thanks, and the meeting was adjourned for dinner and fellowship.



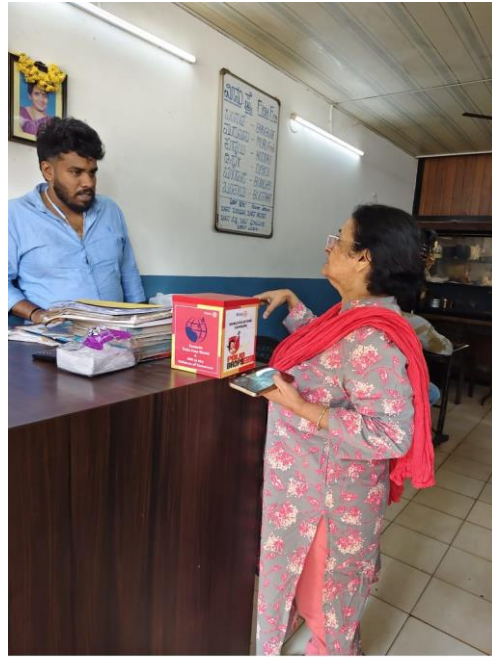
Polio Hundi Drive Report
