

RI President Nominee - selected

Rtn Sangkoo Yun, of the Rotary Club of Sae Hanyang, Seoul, Korea, is the selection of the nominating committee to become Rotary International's president for 2026-27. He will be officially declared the president-nominee on 15 September if no other candidate's challenge him. Yun received his bachelor's and master's degrees from the Syracuse University School of Architecture in the U.S. and an honorary doctoral degree from The University of Edinburgh, Scotland. He is the founder and CEO of Dongsuh Corp., which engineers and markets architectural materials, and the president of Youngan Corp., which operates in real estate and financial investment. He is involved in many civic organizations and has a special interest in the preservation of cultural heritage. A Rotary member since 1987, when he was a charter member of the Rotary Club of Sae Hanyang, Yun has served Rotary International as a director, trustee, committee member and chair, and RI learning facilitator. He served for eight years as co-chair of the Keep Mongolia Green Project, by Korean members of Rotary. His RI committee roles include the Board Administration Committee (2013-15, vice chair 2014-15),



the International Assembly Committee (vice chair, 2020–21), and the End Polio Now Countdown to History Campaign Committee (regional vice chair, 2023–27). He also served on The Rotary Foundation's Executive Committee (2019–22, chair 2020–21) and Programs Committee (2019–22, chair 2020–22).

Yun received The Rotary Foundation's Distinguished Service Award in 2021-22. He was appointed an Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire by Queen Elizabeth II, awarded the Friendship Medal by the president of Mongolia, and recognized for distinguished services by the president and prime minister of Korea. He is a veteran of the Republic of Korea Army and an emeritus elder at Andong Presbyterian Church.

Yun and his spouse, Eunsun, are Rotary Foundation Benefactors, Major Donors, and members of the Arch Klumph Society, the Paul Harris Society, and the Bequest Society. They have two children.



Rotary Governance documents

Rotary's governance documents provide the structure for Rotary International's policies and procedures.

Rotary's constitutional documents

The constitutional documents are the primary governing documents for RI. They provide the foundation of RI's policies and procedures for clubs and districts.

- 1. Constitution of Rotary International
- 2. Bylaws of Rotary International
- 3. Standard Rotary Club Constitution

These documents are updated every three years by the Council on Legislation.

Manual of Procedure

The Manual of Procedure is published every three years to reflect the updated constitutional documents, with the changes adopted by the Council on Legislation. The manual also includes Rotary's Strategic Plan, the Recommended Rotary Club Bylaws, and the Bylaws of The Rotary Foundation. Clubs and districts are guided by the Manual of Procedure.

Rotary's governance documents

In addition to the constitutional documents, Rotary International and The Rotary Foundation have governance documents that detail policies and procedures. These documents can be updated by the RI Board or TRF Trustees at one of their regular meetings. These documents include:

Recommended Rotary Club Bylaws

The Recommended Rotary Club Bylaws provide structure and help clubs govern themselves according to RI's policies and procedures. Clubs can tailor the club bylaws, provided their changes align with Rotary's constitutional documents and the Rotary Code of Policies. If you have questions about your proposed changes, please submit them to the general secretary.

Codes of Policies

The Rotary Code of Policies compiles all of the organization's general and permanent policies. The revised version is available after each meeting of the RI Board and the Council on Legislation. A separate document outlines amendments made to the code whenever it is updated.

The Rotary Foundation Code of Policies is maintained in a separate document. A revised version is available after each meeting of The Rotary Foundation Trustees.






